4. Agricultural Year: starts in October of every year and ends in September of the following year.

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




Estimated Population of Palestinians in the World by Country of Residence, End 2015




Registered Live Births and Deaths** in the West Bank by Month of Birth, Month of Death and Sex, 2014, 2015

Registered Live Births in the West Bank by Month of Birth, 2015






Population Pyramid in Palestine, End 2015




Unemployment Rate of Participants in the Labour Force (15 Years and Above) by Sex and Years of Schooling in Palestine, 2013-2015

Percentage Distribution of Monthly Household Consumption in Jordanian Dinars (JD) in Palestine by Commodities, Service Groups and Region, 2011



Individual Poverty Rates According to Household Consumption in Palestine by Region, 2011






Percentage Distribution of Persons (15 Years and Above) in Palestine by Educational Attainment, 2015






Percentage of Households Which have Computer by Governorate, 2014





Physicians, and Beds per 1000 Population in Palestine, 2000-2014











Percentage Distribution of Guest Nights in the West Bank by Nationality, 2014



Number of Livestock's in Palestine by Type of Livestock, As in 01/10/2013







Percentage Distribution of Economic Establishments in Palestine by the Main Wastewater Disposal Method and Region, 2015


