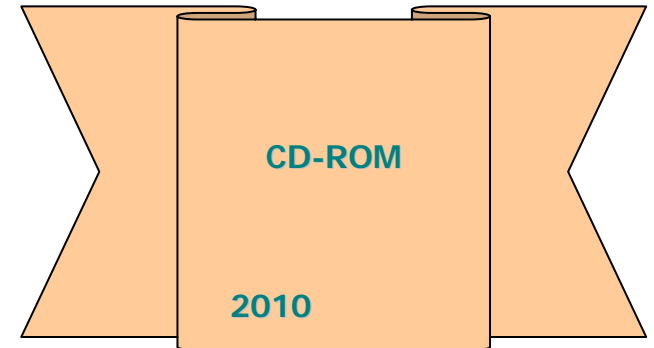

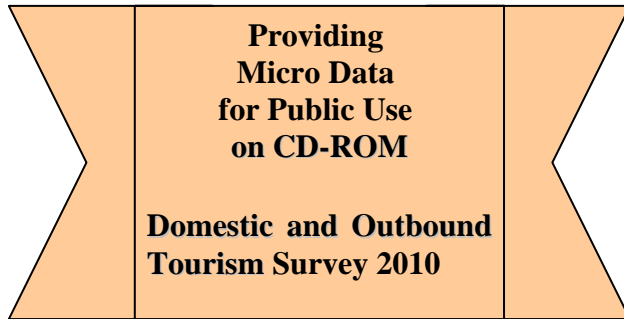

The Palestinian Central Bureau of Statistics (PCBS) has made Micro data from the domestic and outbound tourism survey 2010 available to the public on CD-ROM. The purpose is to facilitate dissemination of statistical reference numbers and to provide up-to-date information and procedures for those who are concerned.

Summary about the Domestic and Outbound Tourism Survey:

PCBS implemented the survey, which was conducted in parallel with the Labor Force Survey in the first quarter 2011. The domestic and outbound tourism survey provides information for the database, this survey reflects the data for the year 2010, and it may provide us main data about the domestic and outbound tourism expenditure which is related to the overnight-stay tourists. And the survey provided data on the members of the household that took part in the trip, the main characteristics of the households that conducted trips, the

length of stay of the trips, and the amount and mode of expenditure during the trips.

Importance of Providing Micro Data:

The need to provide micro data for concerned parties in the form of an expanded database relied on the collection of crucial data regarding many indicators pertinent to domestic and outbound tourism survey.

This survey is significant because of the valuable data it makes available to researchers who, in the past, had to depend on estimations and guess work.

This survey provides data according to indicators in line with international recommendations regarding domestic tourism and tourism expenditure

Data Type and Size:

Data provided by the domestic and outbound tourism survey 2010. All of the indicators refer to the year 2010. The sample size is about 7,124 households.

The sample design took into account the geographic distribution of households in order to ensure full coverage of the various localities. The data are available on SPSS.

Micro Data Beneficiaries:

There are many parties and institutions that can benefit from having an available database of the domestic tourism survey for policy and decision making based on a solid scientific basis. Such parties and institutions include governmental bodies and ministries specialized in this field, such as the Palestinian Legislative Council, the Council of Ministers, Ministry of Tourism and Antiquities, research centers engaged in economic and tourism studies, researchers and universities.

Data Confidentiality:

Data compiled in the context of the domestic tourism and outbound survey involves household and personal data. The confidentiality of such data is honored and safeguarded in accordance with article (17) of the Palestinian General Statistical Law of 2000, which

stipulates: "All individual information and data submitted to the Bureau for statistical purposes shall be treated as confidential and shall not be divulged, in whole or in part, to any individual or to a public or private body, or used for any purpose other than for preparing statistical tables.

How to Obtain Micro Data for Public Use:

The aforementioned database shall be accessible by institutions and individuals.
