Concepts and Definitions

Man power

All persons in the West Bank and Gaza Strip aged 15 years and over.

Reference week:

The week ending on Friday preceding the interviewer's visit to the household.

Employed:

All persons are 15 years and over who were working at a paid job or business for at least one hour during the reference week, or who did not work, but held a job or owned business from which they were temporarily absent (because of illness, vacation, temporarily stoppage, or any other reason) during the reference week. Employed persons are classified according to employment status as follows:

1. Employer
2. Self-employed
3. Employee
4. Unpaid family member

Unemployed (According to the ILO Standards):

Unemployed persons are those individuals 15 years and over who did not work at all during the reference week, who were not absent from a job and were available for work and actively seeking a job during the reference week. Persons who work in Israel and were absent from work due to closure are considered unemployed, and also those persons never work and not looking for work but waiting to return back to their works in Israel and Settlements.

Unemployed (According to the Relaxed Definition):

The number of unemployed persons was calculated under the relaxed definition by adding to unemployed persons according to the ILO Standards, those persons outside labour force because they were frustrated

Labour force:

The economically active population (Labour Force) consists of all persons 15 years and over who are either employed or unemployed as defined above at the time of survey.

Underemployment:

Underemployment exists when a person's employment is inadequate in relation to alternative employment, account being taken of his/her occupational skills.

Persons outside labour force:

The population not economically active comprises all persons 15 years and over, who were neither employed nor unemployed accordingly to the definitions above.

Informal employment:

Comprises the total number of informal jobs, whether carried out formal sector enterprises, informal sector enterprises, or households, during the reference period. It includes the following: employers, self employed, employees holding informal jobs in the formal sector.

Informal sector enterprises:

household enterprises units engaged in the production of goods or services which are not constituted as separate legal entities independently of the households or household members that own them, and for which no complete sets of accounts are available. Household enterprises include unincorporated enterprises owned and operated by individual household members or by two or more members of the same household as well as unincorporated partnerships formed by members of different households.

Press Release on Labour Force Survey Results (October- December, 2008) Round

Unemployment rate registered the highest in Bethlahem governorate among the West Bank Governorates, While Khan Younis Governorate registered the highest among Gaza Strip governorates

This report is based on the labour force quarterly survey. Data was collected during 04/10/2008 to 31/12/2008, representing the 4th quarter 2008.

The survey sample of this round is based on the 1997 census sampling frame (Updated on 2003), 7,546 households were selected to represent the Palestinian society of which 5,915 questionnaires were completed.

Economically Active:

- According to the ILO standards, the labour force participation rate decreased in the Palestinian Territory from 41.6% in the 3rd quarter 2008 to 41.4% in the 4th quarter 2008 the decrease rate was (0.5%), while it remains at the same level compared with the 4th quarter 2007 (41.4%) . The participation rate of women decreased from 15.2% in the 3rd quarter 2008 to 15.0% in the 4th quarter 2008, with a change rate of 1.3% (about 1 thousand woman)

Unemployed Persons

- According to the relaxed definition of unemployment, the percentage of persons who don't work nevertheless seeking or not seeking job, increased from 32.7% in the 3rd quarter 2008 to 33.4% in the 4th quarter 2008, compared with 28.8% in the 4th quarter 2007.
- According to the ILO standards, the percentage of persons who don't work, but seeking job increased from 27.5% in the 3rd quarter 2008 to 27.9% in the 4th quarter 2008, compared with 22.2% in the 4th quarter 2007. The results showed that unemployment rate in the West Bank decreased from 20.7% in the 3rd quarter 2008 to 19.8% in the 4th quarter 2008, while it increased in Gaza Strip from 41.9% in the 3rd quarter 2008 to 44.8% in the 4th quarter 2008.
- Southern governorates registered the highest unemployment rate among the West Bank governorates, Bethlahem governorate registered the highest unemployment rate at (28.9%) followed by Hebron governorate at (28.8%). While Jerusalem and Jericho and AL Aghwar registered the lowest percentages of unemployment (8.7% and 12.8% respectively). While in Gaza Strip, Khan Younis governorate registered the highest percentage of unemployment (47.1%) followed by North Gaza governorate (46.3%), then Gaza governorate (45.5%).
- The results showed that the highest percentage of unemployment was concentrated among youth aged 15-29; The highest rate was among those aged 15-19; it reached 43.0%, thereof 31.1% in the West Bank and 73.2% in Gaza Strip, followed by 20-24 age group it reached 41.1%, thereof 29.8% in the West Bank and 62.1% in Gaza Strip, then 25-29 group, it reached 30.1%, thereof 20.0% in the West Bank and 48.0% in Gaza Strip.
- The results showed that unemployment rate among females who did not complete any years of schooling was 3.1%. Whereas, the percentage reached 30.5% for females completed 13 years of schooling and over compared with 18.6% among males. While the highest rate was among males who completed 1-6 years at 38.1%.

Employed Persons

- The results showed a decrease in the number of employed persons between the 3rd quarter and 4th quarter 2008, the number of employed persons reached 646 thousand in the 4th quarter 2008 compared with 649 thousand in the 3rd quarter 2008, also the results showed significant increased of employed women from 116 thousands to 125 thousands between the 3rd quarter and 4th quarter 2008.

- At economic activity¹ level the results showed that the percentage of those who are working in agriculture sector in the West Bank increased from 14.9% to 16.3% between 3rd quarter and 4th quarter 2008, while the percentage of those who are working in construction sector decreased from 9.7% to 9.1%. While in Gaza Strip the results showed that all activities was affected from the closure imposed by Israeli military authority, for that there was a decrease of those who are working in agriculture sector from 10.6% in the 3rd quarter 2008 to 7.1% in the 4th quarter 2008, also the percentage of employed persons in commerce, restaurants and hotels sector decreased from 18.3% in 3rd quarter to 16.2% in the 4th quarter 2008. On the other hand, the results showed that the percentage of employed persons at services and other branches sector reached 33.9% in the West Bank and 67.9% in Gaza Strip in the 4th quarter 2008.
- The number of employed persons in the West Bank in the agriculture sector increased by 7 thousand between the 3rd and 4th quarter 2008.
- The results in the West Bank showed an increase of the percentage of wage employees, it increased from 62.2% in the 3rd quarter 2008 to 67.9% in the 4th quarter 2008, and unpaid family members increased from 10.5% to 10.7% while the percentage of self employed decreased from 22.8% to 16.4% at the same period.
- While in Gaza Strip the percentage of wage employees increased from 73.3% to 79.0%, whereas the percentage of self employed decreased from 15.7% to 12.0% and the percentage of unpaid family members decreased from 6.4% to 5.5% at the same period.
- The employment from the West Bank in Israel and Israeli settlements decreased from 16.3% in the 3rd quarter 2008 to 16.1% in the 4th quarter 2008, whereas in Gaza Strip there was no access for workers to enter Israeli settlements.
- The results showed that the public sector employed one fourth (25.0%) of total employed, 15.4% in the West Bank and 53.8% in Gaza Strip.
- The percentage of employment in the informal sector form total employment in the Palestinian Territory in the 4th quarter 2008 reached 9.2%; thereof 9.4% in the West Bank and 8.8% in Gaza Strip. While the percentage of employment in the informal sector from workers employed as self employed and employers reached 47.6% in the Palestinian Territory, thereof 44.5% in the West Bank and 59.4% in Gaza Strip.

Wages and Work Hours

- The average value of the nominal daily net wage of employees worked in the West Bank increased from 82.2 NIS in 3rd quarter 2008 to 87.4 NIS in the 4th quarter 2008, compared with 78.9 NIS in the 4th quarter 2007. Also in Gaza Strip the nominal daily net wage of employees increased from 57.1 NIS in the 3rd quarter 2008 and 61.2 NIS in the 4th quarter 2008, compared with 64.1 NIS in the 4th quarter 2007. While the nominal daily net wage for those working in Israel and Israeli settlements remains at the same level 138.0 NIS between the 3rd and 4th quarter 2008, compared with 133.1 NIS in the 4th quarter 2007.
- The average weekly work hours in the West Bank increased from 42.8 work hour in 3rd quarter 2008 to 43.1 work hour in the 4th quarter 2008, while decreased in Gaza Strip from 43.4 work hour to 39.9 work hour, whereas it increased for those working in Israel and Israeli settlements from 42.5 work hour to 44.7 work hour at the same period.
