



## Palestinian Producer Price Index, Increase in the PPI during August 2012

The overall Producer Price<sup>1</sup> Index (PPI) for the Palestinian Territory with its base month (January 2011=100) reached 104.08 in August 2012, it increased by 3.39% compared to July 2012.

Producer Price Index for exported products (January 2011=100) reached 104.96 in August 2012, which indicates an increase by 0.21% compared to July 2012.

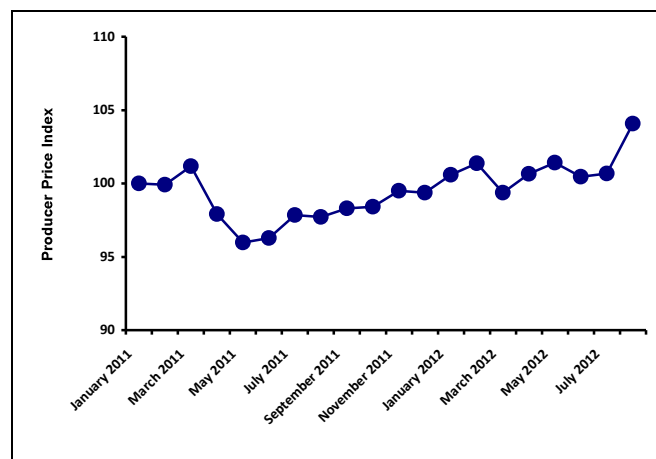
Producer Price Index for locally consumed products (January 2011=100) reached 104.00 in August 2012, which indicates an increase by 3.72% compared to July 2012.

The changes of Producer Price Index for August 2012 is traced back to changes in prices of following major activities compared to the previous month:

Major Groups	%Change
Agriculture goods:	+ 9.40%
Fishing:	+ 0.70%
Mining and quarrying:	0.00%
Manufacturing group:	+ 0.24%

<sup>1</sup> The producer's price is the amount receivable by the producer from the purchaser for a unit of a good or service produced as output minus any VAT, or similar deductible tax, invoiced to the purchaser. The producer's prices exclude any transport charges invoiced separately by the producer.
