Executive Summary

Results reveal that, there are 79 operating hotels in December 2006, offers 4,079 rooms with total available beds of 8,733.

- During the fourth quarter 2006, the total number of guests to the Palestinian Territory hotels reached 37,008, the results indicate that 51.5% from them stayed in Jerusalem hotels.
- Total number of nights was 81,297 and 62.1% from these nights were in Jerusalem hotels
- The number of workers in the hotels were 1,302 of which 1,126 are males and 176 are females. The number of workers declined by 1.2% during the fourth quarter 2006 compared with the third quarter 2006.
- Average occupancy of rooms was 486.1, it declined by 10.7% during the fourth quarter 2006 compared with the third quarter of the same year.
- The percentage of room occupancy was 11.8%, it declined by 15.1% during the fourth quarter 2006 compared with the third quarter 2006.
- The average length of stay in the Palestinian hotels was 2.2 nights per guest during the fourth quarter 2006, with the highest average in Jerusalem hotels, which reached 2.7 nights per guest

Chapter One

Introduction

Tourism is considered as a cornerstone of the Palestinian economy because there are many attractive touristic resorts for people of different interests. Therefore, Palestinian Central Bureau of Statistics (PCBS) commenced to collect statistical data on tourism and monitor hotel activities through a comprehensive survey since First Quarter 1996, and on regular basis. Such activity followed the World Tourism Organization and European Union recommendations. It is aimed to produce a comprehensive database and time series of basic indicators of hotel industry, hoping to enable the development and promotion of the tourism industry in Palestine.

This survey is carried out on monthly basis using a specifically designed questionnaire about hotel guests, nights, workers, facilities.

A quarterly report is regularly produced and a collective comprehensive report is produced annually. This publication presents data on hotels for the fourth quarter 2006.

Chapter Two

Concepts and Definitions

Hotel: It is defined as an accommodation establishment providing

overnight lodging for the visitors in a room or unit. It should hold a number of persons exceeding that of an average single family. The establishment must be under one management, and provides

different facilities and services to visitors.

Hotel Workers: It refers to all persons working in the hotel on full or part time

bases including owners and paid or unpaid household members.

Number of Rooms: It refers to the furnished rooms for the use of guests. Such rooms

might be single, double, triple, or quadruple. Rooms involving more than four beds were classified under (others) in the questionnaire. As for the suite, it is usually comprised of one

bedroom or more, a living room and private toilet facilities.

It refers to beds and rooms, which are ready for use during the

Guests: It refers to visitors staying in the hotels and using their facilities in

Chapter Three

Main Findings

The total number of hotels in the Palestinian Territory is 123 hotels, including the temporary closed hotels. There are 79 operating hotels in December 2006, offers 4,079 rooms with total available beds of 8,733.

• Hotels and Capacity During the Fourth Quarter 2006

The operating hotels within the Palestinian Territory as in June 2006, are distributed as follows:

- North of West Bank: 7 hotels including 112 rooms comprising 264 beds.
- Middle of West Bank: 19 hotels including 892 rooms comprising 2,087 beds.
- Jerusalem Region: 21 hotels including 1,130 rooms comprising 2,443 beds.
- South of West Bank: 20 hotels including 1,542 rooms comprising 3,231 beds.
- Gaza Strip: 12 hotels including 403 rooms comprising 708 beds.

• Hotel Workers During the Fourth Quarter 2006

The number of workers in the hotels administration were 269 of which 223 are males and 46 are females. There were 1,033 workers in hotels services, of which 903 are males and 130 are females.

• Guests and Occupancy During the Fourth Quarter 2006

The total number of guests to the Palestinian hotels was 37,008 persons, of which 31.1% were from the European Union Countries and 16.9% of them were Palestinian guests.

Most of those guests were in Jerusulem hotels with a percentage of 51.5% from the guests total, where as the percentage reached up to 22.2% in the Middle of the West Bank hotels, and

21.3%, 3.3% in the South and North of the West Bank hotels respectively, while percentage of guests in Gaza Strip hotels was 1.7%.




Figure (2): Percentage Distribution of Guests by Nationality During the Fourth Quarter, 2006

The total number of guest nights in the Palestinian hotels during the fourth quarter 2006 was 81,297 nights, of which 36.8% by the guests whom arrived from European Union countries and 11.2% of these nights was occupied by Palestinian guests, while, 10.3% of these nights were occupied by the guests whom arrived from United State of America and Canada.

Whereas the guests spent 62.1% of those nights in Jerusalem hotels, and 13.7%, 20.3%, 2.2% in the Middle, South, and North of the West Bank respectively, while the percentage of guest nights in Gaza Strip hotels was 1.7%.




Figure (3): Number of Guest Nights by Nationality During the Fourth Quarter, 2006

• Room Occupancy During the Fourth Quarter 2006

The average occupancy of rooms in the Palestinian hotels was 486.1, and the percentage occupancy of rooms was 11.8%, whereas, 25.7% the percentage occupancy of rooms in Jerusalem hotels, while its 10.0% in the Middle of the West Bank hotels, and the results indicate that the percentage of rooms occupancy is equal 5.0% and 10.8% in the South and North of the West Bank respectively, and its equal 1.5% in Gaza Strip.




Figure (4): Percentage of Room Occupancy During the Fourth Quarter (1999 - 2006)

• Average Length of Stay During the Fourth Quarter 2006

The average length of stay in the Palestinian hotels was 2.2 nights per guest, and the highest average was 2.7 nights in the Jerusalem hotels while in the North and Middle and South of the West Bank was 1.5, 1.4 and 2.1 nights per guest respectively, and 2.5 nights in Gaza Strip hotels.

The table below presents the main results of the fourth quarter of 2006, and explains the changes occurred on the main indicators of the Palestinian hotels activities, due to the Israeli siege, compared with the same quarter of the year 1999.

Also, the following table indicate that there is a reduction in the number of guests and number of nights in comparison with the same period in year 1999, which reached 62.7% and 71.6% respectively.
