

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

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2008-1997 :2 Figure 2: Registered Marriages & Divorces in Shariah & Church Courts in Ramallah



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
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
Figure 3: Percentage Distribution of Population (15 years and over) in Ramallah & Al-Bireh Governorate by Labor Force Components, 2008

Figure 4: Percentage Distribution of Population(15 years and over) in Ramallah & Al-Bireh Governorate by Labor Force Status, 2003-2008










Figure 5: Number of Schools in Ramallah & Al-Bireh Governorate by Stage and Supervising Authority, 2007/2008



Figure 6: Numbers of Students in Schools in Ramallah & Al-Bireh Governorate by Stage and Supervising Authority, 2007/2008






Figure 7: Distribution of Primary Health Care Clinics and Centers in Ramallah & Al-Bireh Governorate by Supervising Authority, 2004-2008






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


Figure 9: Value of Livestock Production in Ramallah & Al-Bireh Governorate, and the West Bank (1000 US \$), 2006/2007

Figure 10: Percentage Distribution of Households by Type of Housing Unit in


Figure 10: Percentage Distribution of Households by Type of Housing Unit in Ramallah & Al-Bireh Governorate 1997,2007








Figure 12: Issued Building Licenses in Ramallah & Al-Bireh Governorate by Area & Quarter, 2008






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
Figure 13: Distribution of Dumps in Ramallah & Al-Bireh Governorate by Ownership of Dump, 2008



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
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Figure 14: Number of Licensed Road Vehicles in Ramallah & Al-Bireh Governorate by Type of Vehicle, 2008

#### **Executive Summary**

PCBS presents this periodic statistical report about the reality of the Palestinian population in Ramallah and Al Bireh governorate as part of displaying facts about the Palestinian populations in the Palestinian governorates. These are the most prominent findings:

- The population in Ramallah and Al Bireh governorate totaled 292,629 by mid 2009 including 147,192 males and 145,437 females. The percentage of refugees living in Ramallah and Al Bireh governorate totaled 29.3% of the total population of the governorate end year 2007.
- The number of registered marriage certificates at Share'a and church courts during 2008 in Ramallah and Al Bireh governorate totaled 1,804. The number of registered divorce cases at Share'a and church courts totaled 382.
- The registered live births in 2008 in Ramallah and Al Birch governorate totaled 7,049. The number of registered deaths in the governorate for the same year totaled 646.
- The participation rate of labor force (aged 15+) in 2008 in Ramallah and Al Bireh governorate was 43.2%. Findings show that the percentage of the unemployed people among those participating labor force was 17.1%.
- The number of schools and kindergartens in Ramallah and Al Bireh governorate in 2007 2008 was 215 schools and 74 kindergartens.
- The number of hospitals in 2008 in Ramallah and Al Bireh governorate was 9 hospitals. number of hospital beds totaled 313 at 1.10 per 1000 people.
- The area of lands in Ramallah and Al Bireh governorate 2007 was 855 square kilometers.
- 40,164 dunums of field crops cultivated land at a production capacity of 5,869 tons. The area planted with trees totaled 161,505 dunums producing 10,048 tons and the area planted with vegetables totaled 6,803 dunums producing 6,155 tons in Agricultural year 2006/2007.
- The number of occupied houses in Ramallah and Al Bireh governorate totaled 49,637 in 2007
- The number of building licenses in Ramallah and Al Bireh governorate in 2008 totaled 538 for an area of 383,600 square meters.
- The number of localities in Ramallah and Al Bireh governorate in 2008 according to the main source of electricity and water networks is 74 localities, one locality without water network and electricity.
- The number of licensed vehicles in 2008 in Ramallah and Al Bireh governorate was 29,969.
- The number of hotels in 2008 in Ramallah and Al Birch governorate totaled 15.
- The values of imports rose in Ramallah and Al Bireh governorate in 2007 compared to 2003–2006 reaching 1,019 million US\$.
- Exports in Ramallah and Al Bireh governorate in 2007 rose, in comparison with 2003–2006, reaching 117.3 million US\$.
- There was a chronic deficit in the trade balance of Ramallah and Al Bireh governorate in 2007 totaling 901.7 million US\$.

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
