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Executive Summary

PCBS presents this periodic statistical report about the reality of the Palestinian population in Bethlehem governorate as part of displaying facts about the Palestinian populations in the Palestinian governorates. These are the most prominent findings:

- The population in Bethlehem governorate totaled 183,804 by mid 2009 including 93,556 males and 90,248 females. The percentage of refugees living in Bethlehem governorate totaled 28.4% of the total population of the governorate end year 2007.
- The number of registered marriage certificates at Share'a courts during 2008 in Bethlehem governorate totaled 494. The number of registered divorce cases at Share'a courts totaled 111.
- The registered live births in 2008 in Bethlehem governorate totaled 5,020. The registered deaths in the governorate for the same year totaled 516.
- The participation rate of labor force (aged 15+) in 2008 in Bethlehem governorate was 47.1%. Findings showed that the percentage of the unemployed people among those participating labor force was 20.9%.
- The number of schools and kindergartens in Bethlehem governorate in 2007/2008 was 145 schools and 51 kindergartens.
- The number of hospitals in 2008 in Bethlehem governorate was 8 hospitals. number of hospital beds totaled 590 at 3.3 per 1000 people.
- The area of lands in Bethlehem governorate by 2007 was 659 square kilometers.
- 10,521 dunums of field crops cultivated land at a production capacity of 1,412 tons. The area planted with trees totaled 44,784 dunums producing 10,192 tons and the area planted with vegetables totaled 2,651 dunums producing 7,365 tons in Agricultural year 2006/2007.
- The number of occupied houses in Bethlehem governorate totaled 31,471 in 2007.
- The number of building licenses in Bethlehem governorate in 2008 totaled 314 for an area of 135,200 square meters.
- The number of localities in Bethlehem governorate in 2008 according to the main source of water networks is 45 localities. Electricity network was the main source for 42 localities, and 3 localities were without electricity.
- The number of licensed vehicles in 2007 in Bethlehem governorate was 8,824.
- The number of hotels in 2008 in Bethlehem governorate totaled 21.
- The values of imports rose in Bethlehem governorate in 2007 compared to 2003–2006, reaching 150.1 million US\$.
- Exports in Bethlehem governorate in 2007 rose, in comparison with 2003–2006, reaching 80.7 million US\$.
- There was deficit in the trade balance of Bethlehem governorate in 2007 totaling 69.4 million US\$.

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
