





Figure 1: Population in Jenin Governorate Mid-Year, 1997-2009











Figure 3: Percentage Distribution of Population (15 years and over) in Jenin Governorate by Labor Force Components, 2008

Figure 4: Percentage Distribution of Population(15 years and over) in Jenin Governorate by Labor Force Status, 2003-2008










Figure 5: Number of Schools in Jenin Governorate by Stage and Supervising Authority, 2007/2008


Figure 6: Number of Students in Schools in Jenin Governorate by Stage and Supervising Authority, 2007/2008



Figure 7: Distribution of Primary Health Care Clinics and Centers in Jenin Governorate by Supervising Authority, 2004-2008






Figure 8: Cultivated Areas of Field Crops, Fruit Trees and Vegetables in Jenin Governorate, 2006/2007

Figure 9: Value of Livestock Production in Jenin Governorate, and the West Bank (1000 US \$), 2006/2007




Figure 10: Percentage Distribution of Households by Type of Housing Unit in Jenin Governorate 1997,2007












2008 :12 Figure 12: Issued Building Licenses in Jenin Governorate by Area & Quarter, 2008



#### **Executive Summary**

PCBS presents this periodic statistical report about the reality of the Palestinian population in the Jenin governorate as part of displaying facts about the Palestinian populations in the Palestinian governorates. These are the most prominent findings:

- The population in Jenin governorate totaled 267,027 by mid 2009 including 135,650 males and 131,377 females. The percentage of refugees living in Jenin governorate totaled 32.8% of the total population of the governorate end year 2007.
- The number of registered marriage certificates at Share'a courts during 2008 in Jenin governorate totaled 2,326. The number of registered divorce cases at Share'a courts totaled 272.
- The number registered live births in 2008 in Jenin governorate totaled 7,222. The number of registered deaths in the governorate for the same year totaled 815.
- The participation rate of labor force (aged 15+) in 2008 in Jenin governorate is 44.4%. Findings show that the percentage of unemployed people among those participating in labor force is 22.5%.
- The number of schools and kindergartens in Jenin governorate in 2007/2008 was 223 schools and 91 kindergartens.
- The number of hospitals in 2008 in Jenin governorate was 3 hospitals. Number of hospital beds totaled 187 at 0.7 per 1000 people.
- The area of lands in Jenin governorate in 2007 was 583 square kilometers.
- 196,785 dunums of trees cultivated land at a production capacity of 12,404 tons. The area planted with field crops totaled 129,964 dunums producing 48,223 tons and the area planted with vegetables totaled 28,317 dunums producing 94,498 tons in Agricultural year 2006/2007.
- The number of occupied houses in Jenin governorate totaled 46,541 in 2007.
- The number of building licenses in Jenin governorate in 2008 totaled 260 for an area of 104,100 square meters.
- The number of localities in Jenin governorate Where there is a water network is 50 localities in 2008, and 30 localities without water network. Electricity network was the main source for 76 localities, and 4 localities were without electricity.
- The number of licensed vehicles in 2008 in Jenin & Tubas governorates was 10,366.
- The values of imports rose in Jenin & Tubas governorates in 2007 compared to 2003 2006 reaching US\$ 186.2 million US\$.
- Exports in Jenin & Tubas governorates in 2007 rose, in comparison with 2003–2006, reaching US\$ 27.8 million US\$.
- There was deficit in the trade balance of Jenin & Tubas governorates in 2007 totaling US\$ 158.4 million US\$.
