

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

Figure 2: Registered Marriages and Divorces in Shariah and Church Courts in Tubas Governorate, 1997-2008



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
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



Figure 3: Percentage Distribution of Population (15 years and over) in Tubas Governorate by Labor Force Components, 2008

Figure 4: Percentage Distribution of Population(15 years and over) in Tubas Governorate by Labor Force Status, 2003-2008











Figure 5: Number of Schools in Tubas Governorate by Stage and Supervising **Authority, 2007/2008**

Supervising Authority, 2007/2008








Figure 7: Cultivated Areas and Production of Field Crops, Fruit Trees and Vegetables in Tubas Governorate, 2006/2007



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Figure 9: Percentage Distribution of Households by Type of Housing Unit in Tubas Governorate 1997,2007


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




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Executive Summary

PCBS presents this periodic statistical report about the reality of the Palestinian population in Tubas governorate as part of displaying facts about the Palestinian populations in the Palestinian governorates. These are the most prominent findings:

- The population in Tubas governorate totaled 52,950 by mid 2009 including 26,899 males and 26,051 females. The percentage of refugees living in Tubas governorate totaled 15.6 % of the total population of the governorate end year 2007.
- The number of registered marriage certificates at Share'a and church courts during 2008 in Tubas governorate totaled 417. The number of registered divorce cases at Share'a courts totaled 32.
- The number registered live births in 2008 in Tubas governorate totaled 1,220. The number of registered deaths in the governorate for the same year totaled 136.
- The participation rate of labor force (aged 15+) in 2008 in Tubas governorate is 41.5%. Findings shows that the percentage of unemployed people among those participating in the labor force was 16.7%.
- The number of schools and kindergartens in Tubas governorate in 2007/2008 was 39 schools and 19 kindergartens.
- The area of lands in Tubas governorate in 2007 was 402 square kilometers.
- 40,030 dunums of field crops cultivated land at a production capacity of 22,660 tons. The area planted with vegetables totaled 20,475 dunums producing 55,055 tons and the area planted with trees totaled 18,816 dunums producing 2,052 tons in Agricultural year 2006/2007.
- The number of occupied houses in Tubas governorate totaled 8,628 in 2007.
- The number of building licenses in Tubas governorate in 2008 totaled 152 for an area of 38,100 square meters.
- The number of localities in Tubas governorate in 2008 according to the main source of water networks is 9 localities, and 12 localities without water network. Electricity network was the main source for 14 localities, and 7 localities without electricity.
- The number of licensed vehicles in 2008 in Jenin & Tubas governorates was 10,336.
- The values of imports rose in Jenin & Tubas governorates in 2007 compared to 2003 2006 reaching 186.2 million US\$.
- Exports in Jenin & Tubas governorates in 2007 rose, in comparison with 2003 2006, reaching 27.8 million US\$.
- There was a chronic deficit in the trade balance of Jenin & Tubas governorates in 2007 totaling 158.4 million US\$.

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
