

Figure 4: Estimated Banulation in Tubes Covernance Mid Year 1997 30










Figure 3: Percentage Distribution of Population (15 years and over) in Tubas Governorate by Labor Force Components, 2009






Figure 4: Percentage Distribution of Population(15 years and over) in Tubas Governorate by Labor Force Status, 2004-2009












Figure 8: Value of Livestock Production in Tubas Governorate, and the West



igure 9: Percentage Distribution of Households by Type of Housing Ur





Executive Summary

PCBS presents this periodic statistical report about the reality of the Palestinian population in Tubas governorate as part of displaying facts about the Palestinian populations in the Palestinian governorates. These are the most prominent findings:

- The population in Tubas governorate totaled 54,765 by mid 2010 including 27,821 males and 26,944 females. The percentage of refugees living in Tubas governorate totaled 15.6 % of the total population of the governorate end year 2007.
- The number of registered marriage certificates at Share'a and Church courts during 2009 in Tubas governorate totaled 446. The number of registered divorce cases at Share'a courts totaled 66.
- The number registered live births in 2009 in Tubas governorate totaled 1,114. The number of registered deaths in the governorate for the same year totaled 147.
- The participation rate of labor force (aged 15+) in 2009 in Tubas governorate is 45.2%. Findings shows that the percentage of unemployed people among those participating in the labor force was 13.3%.
- The number of schools and kindergartens in Tubas governorate in 2008/2009 was 37 schools and 16 kindergartens.
- The area of lands in Tubas governorate in 2008 was 402 square kilometers.
- 63,280 dunums of field crops cultivated land at a production capacity of 23,135 tons. The area planted with vegetables totaled 19,936 dunums producing 59,709 tons and the area planted with trees totaled 18,924 dunums producing 1,588 tons in Agricultural year 2007/2008.
- The number of occupied houses in Tubas governorate totaled 8,628 in 2007.
- The number of building licenses in Tubas governorate in 2009 totaled 251 for an area of 61,300 square meters.
- The number of localities in Tubas governorate in 2008 according to the main source of water networks is 9 localities, and 12 localities without water network. Electricity network was the main source for 14 localities, and 7 localities without electricity.
- The number of licensed vehicles in 2008 in Jenin & Tubas governorates was 10,336.
- The values of imports rose in Jenin & Tubas governorates in 2008 compared to 2004 2007 reaching US\$ 267.5 million US\$.
- Exports in Jenin & Tubas governorates in 2008 rose, in comparison with 2004–2007, reaching US\$ 39.1 million US\$.
- There was deficit in the trade balance of Jenin & Tubas governorates in 2008 totaling US\$ 228.5 million US\$.
