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

Figure 1: Estimated Population in Jenin Governorate Mid-Year, 1997-2010




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





Figure 4: Percentage Distribution of Population (15 years and over) in Jenin Governorate by Labor Force Components, 2009






Figure 5: Percentage Distribution of Population(15 years and over) in Jenin Governorate by Labor Force Status, 2004-2009






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

Figure 6: Number of Schools in Jenin Governorate by Stage and Supervising Authority, 2008/2009





Figure 7: Number of Students in Schools in Jenin Governorate by Stage and Supervising Authority, 2008/2009






Figure 8: Cultivated Areas of Field Crops, Fruit Trees and Vegetables in Jenin Governorate, 2007/2008

Figure 9: Value of Livestock Production in Jenin Governorate, and the West Bank (1000 US \$), 2007/2008




Figure 10: Percentage Distribution of Households by Type of Housing Unit in Jenin Governorate 1997, 2007







Figure 12: Issued Building Licenses in Jenin Governorate by Area & Quarter, 2009



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Executive Summary

PCBS presents this periodic statistical report about the reality of the Palestinian population in the Jenin governorate as part of displaying facts about the Palestinian populations in the Palestinian governorates. These are the most prominent findings:

- The population in Jenin governorate totaled 274,001 by mid 2010 including 139,193 males and 134,808 females. The percentage of refugees living in Jenin governorate totaled 32.8% of the total population of the governorate end year 2007.
- The number of registered marriage certificates at Share'a courts during 2009 in Jenin governorate totaled 2,510. The number of registered divorce cases at Share'a courts totaled 307.
- The number registered live births in 2009 in Jenin governorate totaled 6,969. The number of registered deaths in the governorate for the same year totaled 833.
- The number of hospitals in 2009 in Jenin governorate was 3 hospitals. Number of hospital beds totaled 160 at 0.6 per 1000 people.
- The participation rate of labor force (aged 15+) in 2009 in Jenin governorate is 43.1%. Findings show that the percentage of unemployed people among those participating in labor force is 18.8%.
- The number of schools and kindergartens in Jenin governorate in 2009/2008 was 222 schools and 85 kindergartens.
- The area of lands in Jenin governorate in 2008 was 583 square kilometers.
- 197,217 dunums of trees cultivated land at a production capacity of 12,732 tons. The area planted with field crops totaled 127,166 dunums producing 49,576 tons and the area planted with vegetables totaled 26,607 dunums producing 125,235 tons in Agricultural year 2008/2007.
- The number of occupied houses in Jenin governorate totaled 46,541 in 2008.
- The number of building licenses in Jenin governorate in 2009 totaled 278 for an area of 93,800 square meters.
- The number of localities in Jenin governorate where there is a water network is 50 localities in 2008, and 30 localities without water network. Electricity network was the main source for 76 localities, and 4 localities were without electricity.
- The number of licensed vehicles in 2008 in Jenin & Tubas governorates was 10,366.
- The values of imports rose in Jenin & Tubas governorates in 2008 compared to 2004 2007 reaching US\$ 267.5 million US\$.
- Exports in Jenin & Tubas governorates in 2008 rose, in comparison with 2004–2007, reaching US\$ 39.1 million US\$.
- There was deficit in the trade balance of Jenin & Tubas governorates in 2008 totaling US\$ 228.5 million US\$.

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
