

Figure 2: Registered Marriages and Divorces in Shariah and Church Courts in Nablus Governorate, 1998-2009







Figure 3: Distribution of Primary Health Care Clinics and Centers in Nablus Governorate by Supervising Authority, 2004-2009












Figure 4: Percentage Distribution of Population (15 years and over) in Nablus Governorate by Labor Force Components, 2009





Figure 7: Number of Students in Schools in Nablus Governorate by Stage and Supervising Authority, 2008/2009







Figure 10: Percentage distribution of Households by type of housing Unit in Nablus Governorate 1997, 2007







Figure 12: Issued Building Licenses in Nablus Governorate by Area & Quarter, 2009









Executive Summary

PCBS presents this periodic statistical report about the reality of the Palestinian population in Nablus governorate as part of displaying facts about the Palestinian populations in the Palestinian governorates. These are the most prominent findings:

- The population in Nablus governorate totaled 340,117 by mid 2010 including 172,099 males and 168,018 females. The percentage of refugees living in Nablus governorate totaled 26.3% of the total population of the governorate end year 2007.
- The number of registered marriage certificates at Shariah and church courts during 2009 in Nablus governorate totaled 2,714. The number of registered divorce cases at Shariah and church courts totaled 470.
- The number registered live births in 2009 in Nablus governorate totaled 8,923. The number of registered deaths in the governorate for the same year totaled 1,016.
- The number of hospitals in 2009 in Nablus governorate was 6 hospitals. Number of hospital beds totaled 465 at 1.4 per 1000 people.
- The Participation Rate of labor force (aged 15+) in 2009 in Nablus governorate is 41.9%. Findings showed that the percentage of unemployed people among those participating labor force was 12.9%.
- The number of schools and kindergartens in Nablus governorate in 2008/2009 was 258 schools and 116 kindergartens.
- The area of lands in Nablus governorate in 2008 was 605 square kilometers.
- 201,757 dunums of trees cultivated land at a production capacity of 32,772 tons. The area planted with field crops totaled 38,419 dunums producing 13,966 tons and the area planted with vegetables totaled 5,911 dunums producing 18,325 tons in Agricultural year 2007/2008.
- The number of occupied houses in Nablus governorate totaled 58,750 in 2007.
- The number of building licenses in Nablus governorate in 2009 totaled 1,325 for an area of 407.6 Thousand square meters.
- The number of localities in Nablus governorate in 2008 according to the main source of water networks is 40 localities, and 24 localities without water network. Electricity network was the main source for 64 localities.
- The number of licensed vehicles in 2009 in Nablus governorates was 25,068.
- The number of hotels in 2009 in Nablus governorate totaled 6.
- The values of imports rose in Nablus & Salfit governorates in 2008 compared to 2004–2007, reaching 453.8 million US\$.
- Exports in Nablus & Salfit governorates in 2008 rose, in comparison with 2004–2007, reaching 95.8 million US\$.
- There was deficit in the trade balance of Nablus & Salfit governorates in 2008 totaling 358.0 million US\$.
