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







Figure 3: Distribution of Primary Health Care Clinics and Centers in Qalqiliya Governorate by Supervising Authority, 2004-2009













Figure 4: Percentage Distribution of Population (15 years and over) in Qalqiliya Governorate by Labor Force Components, 2009


Figure 5: Percentage Distribution of Population (15 years and over) in Qalqiliya
Governorate by Labor Force Status, 2004-2009








Figure 7: Number of Students in Schools in Qalqiliya Governorate by Stage and




Figure 8: Cultivated Areas of Field Crops, Fruit Trees and Vegetables in Qalqiliya Governorate, 2007/2008



Figure 9: Value of Livestock Production in Qalqiliya Governorate, and the West Bank (1000 US \$), 2007/2008






Figure 10: Percentage Distribution of Households by Type of Housing Unit in Qalqiliya Governorate 1997, 2007








Figure 12: Issued Building Licenses in Qalqiliya Governorate by Area & Quarter, 2009






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Figure 13: Distribution of Dumps in Qalqiliya Governorate by Ownership of Dump, 2008



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

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#### **Executive Summary**

PCBS presents this periodic statistical report about the reality of the Palestinian population in Qalqiliya governorate as part of displaying facts about the Palestinian populations in the Palestinian governorates. These are the most prominent findings:

- The population in Qalqiliya governorate totaled 97,447 by mid 2010 including 49,991 males and 47,456 females. The percentage of refugees living in Qalqiliya governorate totaled 47.0% of the total population of the governorate end year 2007.
- The number of registered marriage certificates at Shariah and church courts during 2009 in Qalqiliya governorate totaled 823. The number of registered divorce cases at Shariah and church courts totaled 158.
- The number registered live births in 2009 in Qalqiliya governorate totaled 2,981. The number of registered deaths in the governorate for the same year totaled 296.
- The number of hospitals in 2009 in Qalqiliya governorate was 3 hospitals. Number of hospital beds totaled 133 at 1.4 per 1000 people.
- The Participation Rate of labor force (aged 15+) in 2009 in Qalqiliya governorate is 43.9%. Findings showed that the percentage of unemployed people among those participating labor force was 23.4%.
- The number of schools and kindergartens in Qalqiliya governorate in 2008/2009 was 80 schools and 25 kindergartens.
- The area of lands in Qalqiliya governorate in 2008 was 166 square kilometers.
- 63,059 dunums of trees cultivated land at a production capacity of 15,147 tons. The area planted with vegetables totaled 5,973 dunums producing 39,206 tons and the area planted with field crops totaled 3,640 dunums producing 1,411 tons in Agricultural year 2007/2008.
- The number of occupied houses in Qalqiliya governorate totaled 16,036 in 2007.
- The number of building licenses in Qalqiliya governorate in 2009 totaled 340 for an area of 94.5 Thousand square meters.
- The number of localities in Qalqiliya Governorate in 2008 according to the main source of water networks is 28 localities, and 6 localities without water network. Electricity network was the main source for 31 localities, and 3 localities were without electricity.
- The number of licensed vehicles in 2009 in Qalqiliya governorates was 4,368.
- The values of imports rose in Qalqiliya governorates in 2008 compared to 2004–2007, reaching 99.3 million US\$.
- Exports in Qalqiliya governorates in 2008 fall, in comparison with 2004–2007, reaching 14.9 million US\$.
- There was deficit in the trade balance of Qalqiliya governorates in 2008 totaling 84.4 million US\$.

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
