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
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Figure 1: Estimated Population in Jericho & Al Aghwar Governorate Mid-Year, 1997-2010

Figure 2: Registered Marriages and Divorces in Shariah and Church Courts in Jericho & Al Aghwar Governorate, 1998-2009




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

Figure 3: Distribution of Primary Health Care Clinics and Centers in Jericho & Al Aghwar Governorate by Supervising Authority, 2004-2009











Figure 4: Percentage Distribution of Population (15 years and over) in Jericho & Al Aghwar Governorate by Labor Force Components, 2009

& Al Aghwar Governorate by Labor Force Status, 2004-2009






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

Figure 6: Number of Schools in Jericho & Al Aghwar Governorate by Stage and Supervising Authority, 2008/2009





Figure 7: Number of Students in Schools in Jericho & Al Aghwar Governorate by Stage and Supervising Authority, 2008/2009





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


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

Figure 9: Value of Livestock Production in Jericho & Al Aghwar Governorate, and the West Bank (1000 US \$), 2007/2008



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
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
Figure 10: Percentage distribution of Households by type of housing Unit in Jericho & Al Aghwar Governorate 1997, 2007








Figure 12: Issued Building Licenses in Jericho & Al Aghwar Governorate by Area & Quarter, 2009







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#### **Executive Summary**

PCBS presents this periodic statistical report about the reality of the Palestinian population in Jericho & Al Aghwar governorate as part of displaying facts about the Palestinian populations in the Palestinian governorates. These are the most prominent findings:

- The population in Jericho & Al Aghwar governorate totaled 45,433 by mid 2010 including 22,762 males and 22,671 females. The percentage of refugees living in Jericho & Al Aghwar governorate totaled 51.3% of the total population of the governorate end year 2007.
- Number of registered marriage certificates at Shariah and church courts during 2009 in Jericho & Al Aghwar governorate totaled 314. The number of registered divorce cases at Shariah and church courts totaled 51.
- Number registered live births in 2009 in Jericho & Al Aghwar governorate totaled 2,091. Number of registered deaths in the governorate for the same year totaled 113.
- Number of hospitals in 2009 in Jericho & Al Aghwar governorate was one hospital. Number of hospital beds totaled 53 at 1.2 per 1000 people.
- The Participation Rate of labor force (aged 15+) in 2009 in Jericho & Al Aghwar governorate is %49.3. Findings showed that the percentage of unemployed people among those participating labor force was %8.0.
- Number of schools and kindergartens in Jericho & Al Aghwar governorate in 2008/2009 was 30 schools and 13 kindergartens.
- The area of lands in Jericho & Al Aghwar governorate in 2008 was 593 square kilometers.
- 36,931 dunums of vegetables cultivated land at a production capacity of 97,113 tons. The area planted with trees totaled 6,903 dunums producing 8,792 tons and the area planted with field crops totaled 5,438 dunums producing 2,926 tons in Agricultural year 2007/2008.
- Number of occupied houses in Jericho & Al Aghwar governorate totaled 7,262 in 2007.
- Number of building licenses in Jericho & Al Aghwar governorate in 2009 totaled 90 for an area of 24.6 Thousand square meters.
- Number of localities in Jericho & Al Aghwar governorate in 2008 according to the main source of water networks is 14 localities. Electricity network was the main source for 13 localities, and one locality without Electricity
- Number of licensed vehicles in 2009 in Jericho & Al Aghwar governorates was 2,331.
- Number of hotels in 2009 in Jericho & Al Aghwar governorate totaled 7.
- The values of imports fall in Jericho & Al Aghwar governorates in 2008 compared to 2004–2007, reaching 36.7 million US\$.
- Exports in Jericho & Al Aghwar governorates in 2008 rose, in comparison with 2004–2007, reaching 3.2 million US\$.
- There was deficit in the trade balance of Jericho & Al Aghwar governorates in 2008 totaling 33.6 million US\$.

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
