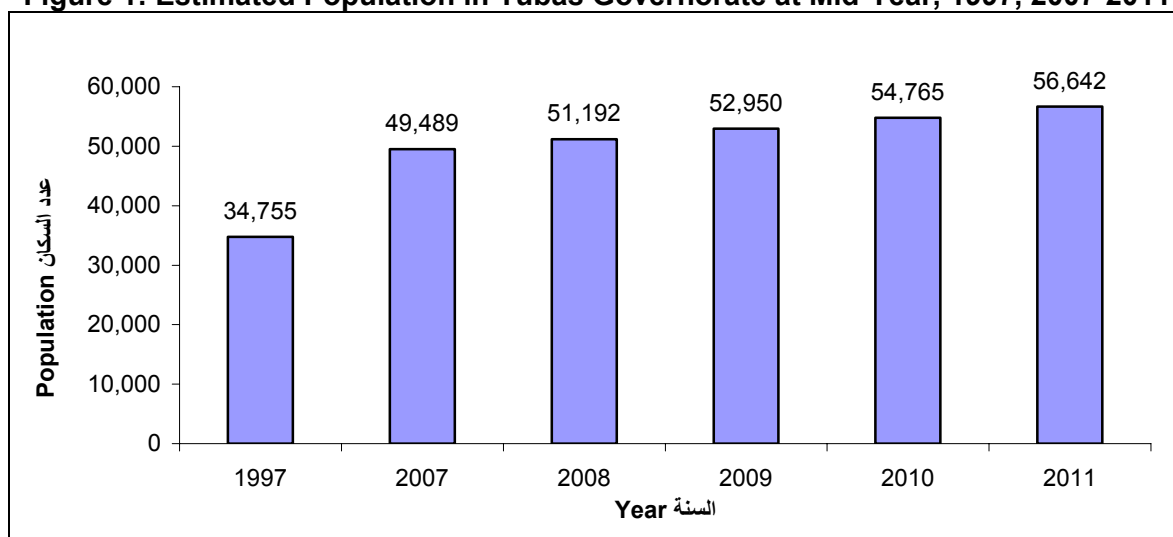

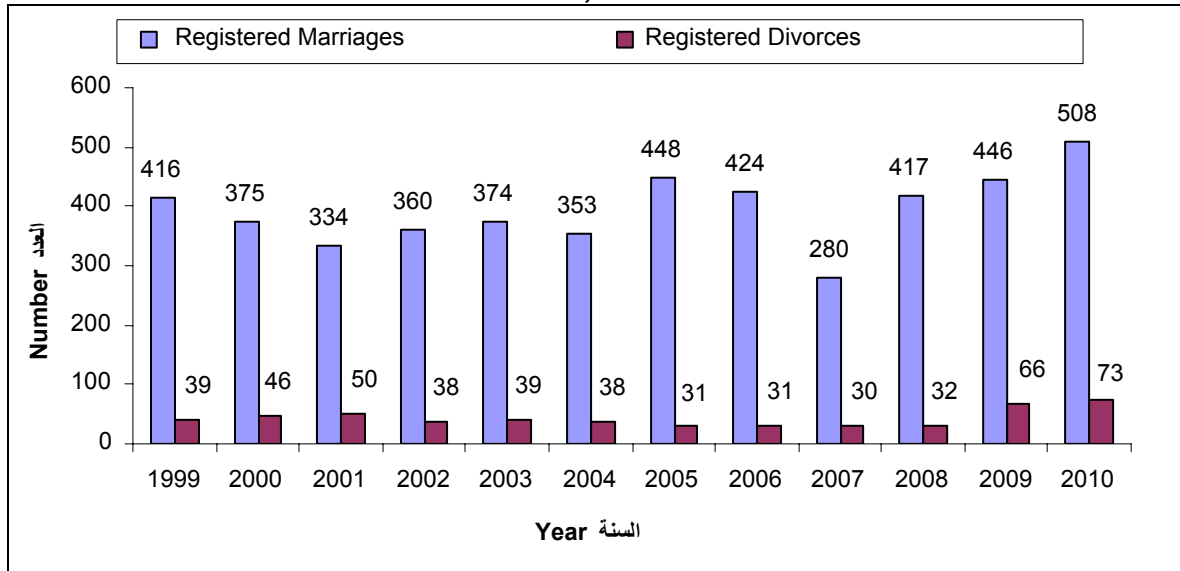

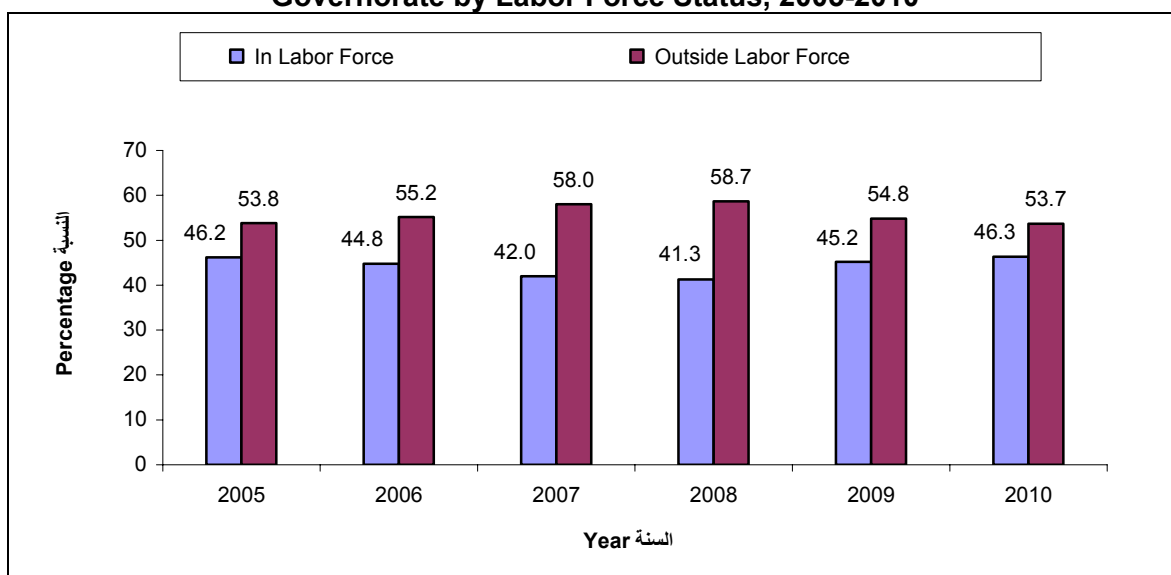

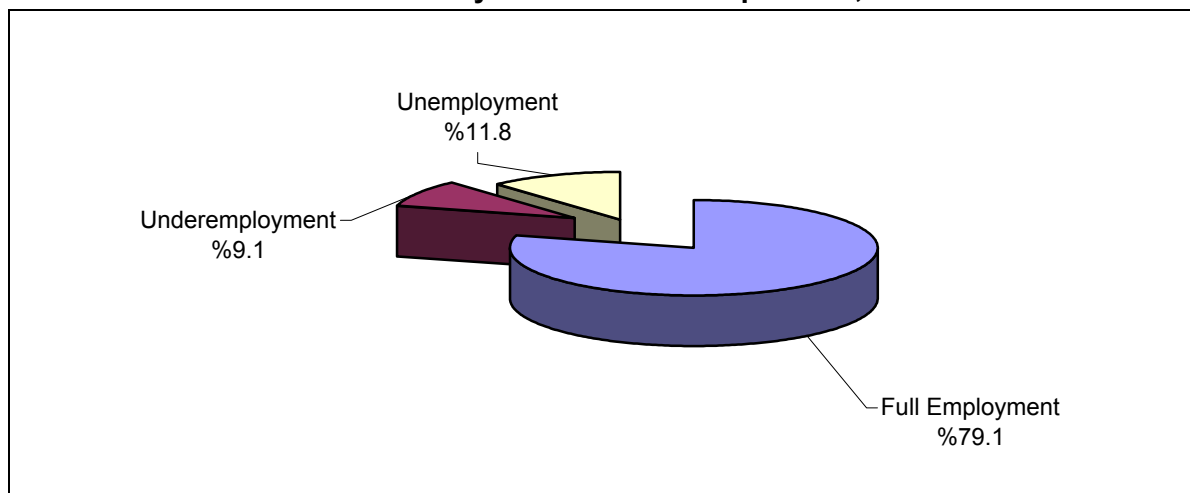

Figure 4: Percentage Distribution of Population (15 Years and Above) in Tubas Governorate by Labor Force Components, 2010



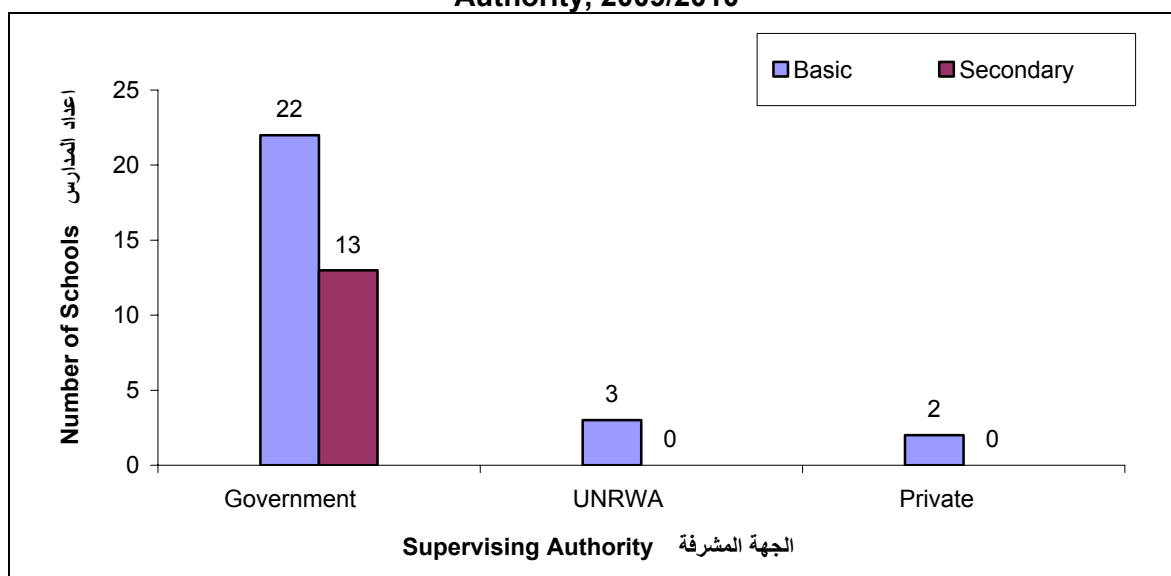

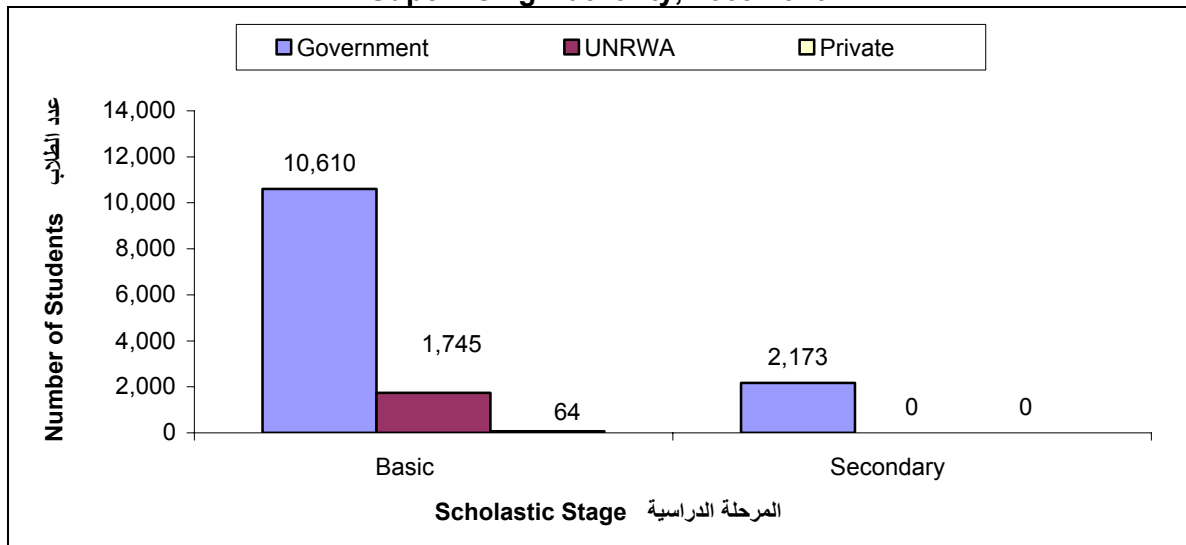
Figure 5: Number of Schools in Tubas Governorate by Stage and Supervising Authority, 2009/2010

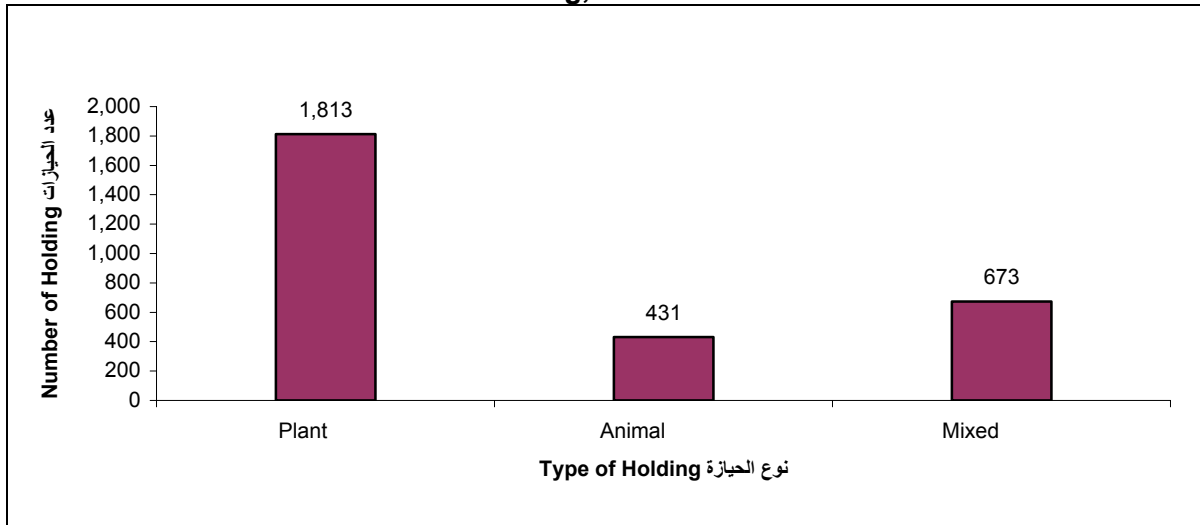

Figure 7: Number of Agricultural Holdings in Tubas Governorate by Type of Holding, 2009/2010

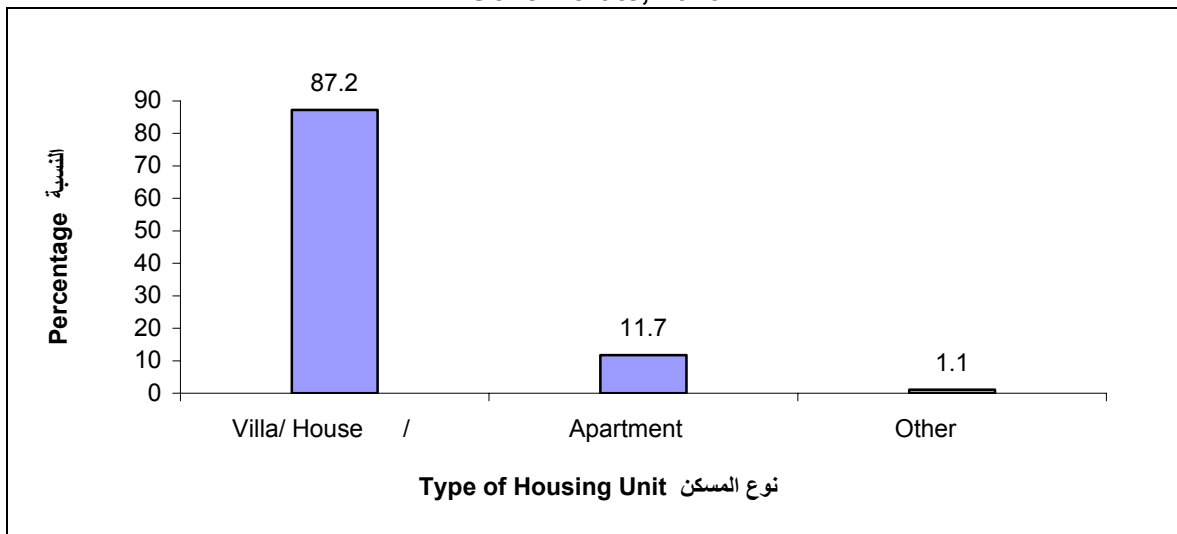

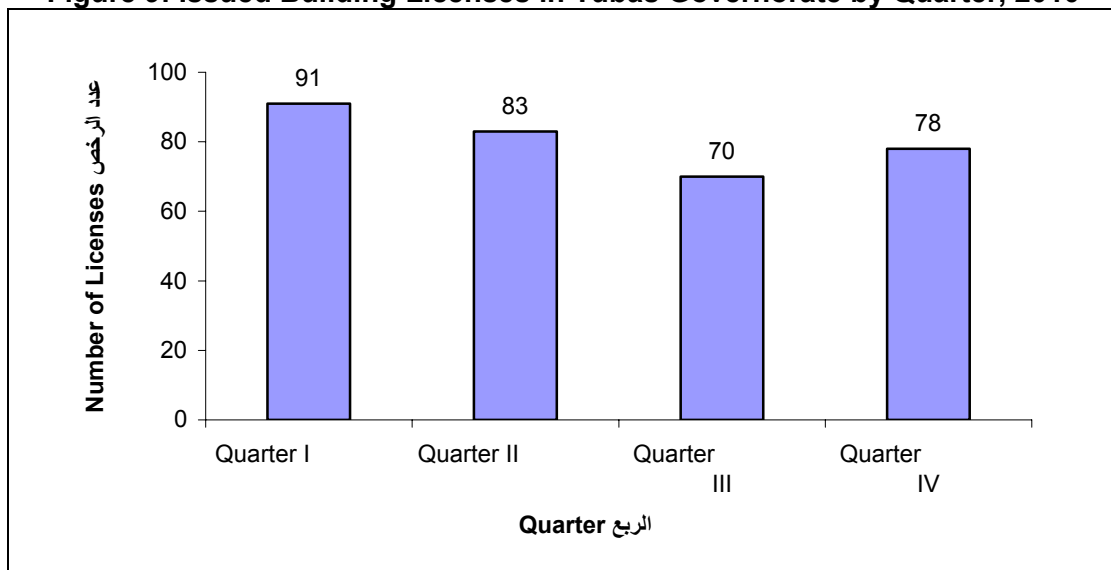
Figure 8: Percentage Distribution of Households by type of housing Unit in Tubas Governorate, 2010

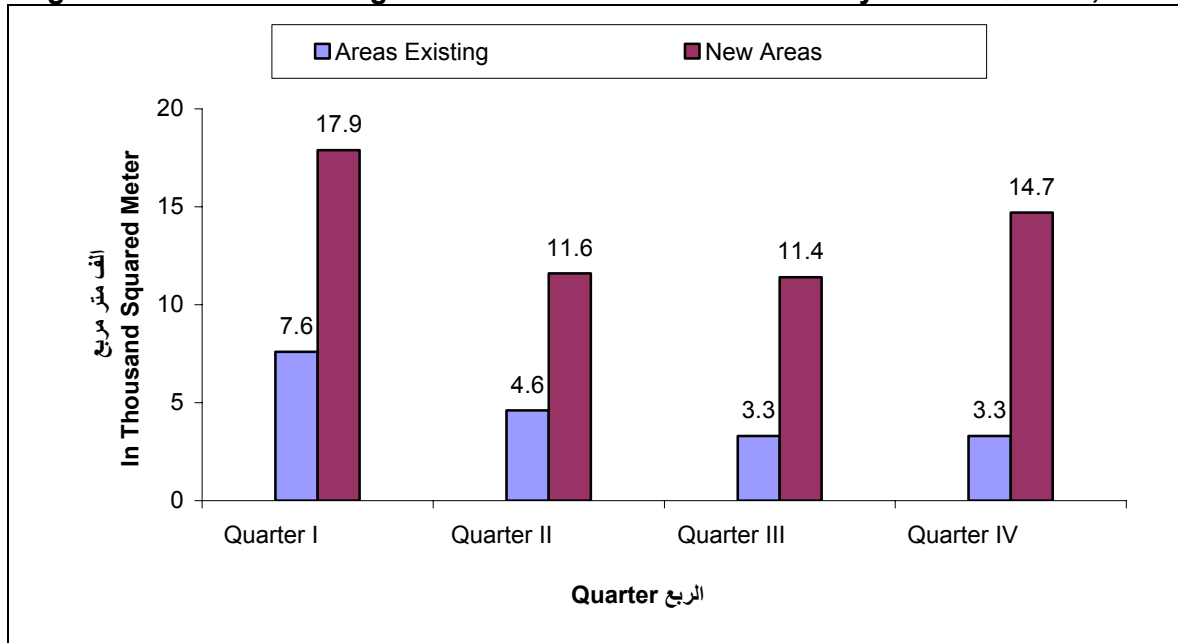

Figure 10: Issued Building Licenses in Tubas Governorate by Area & Quarter, 2010



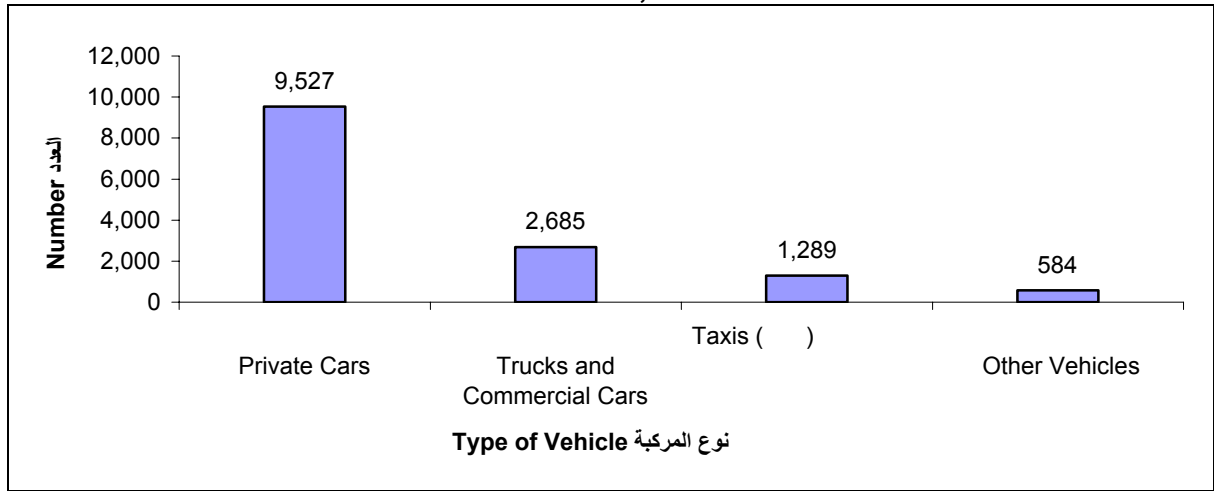

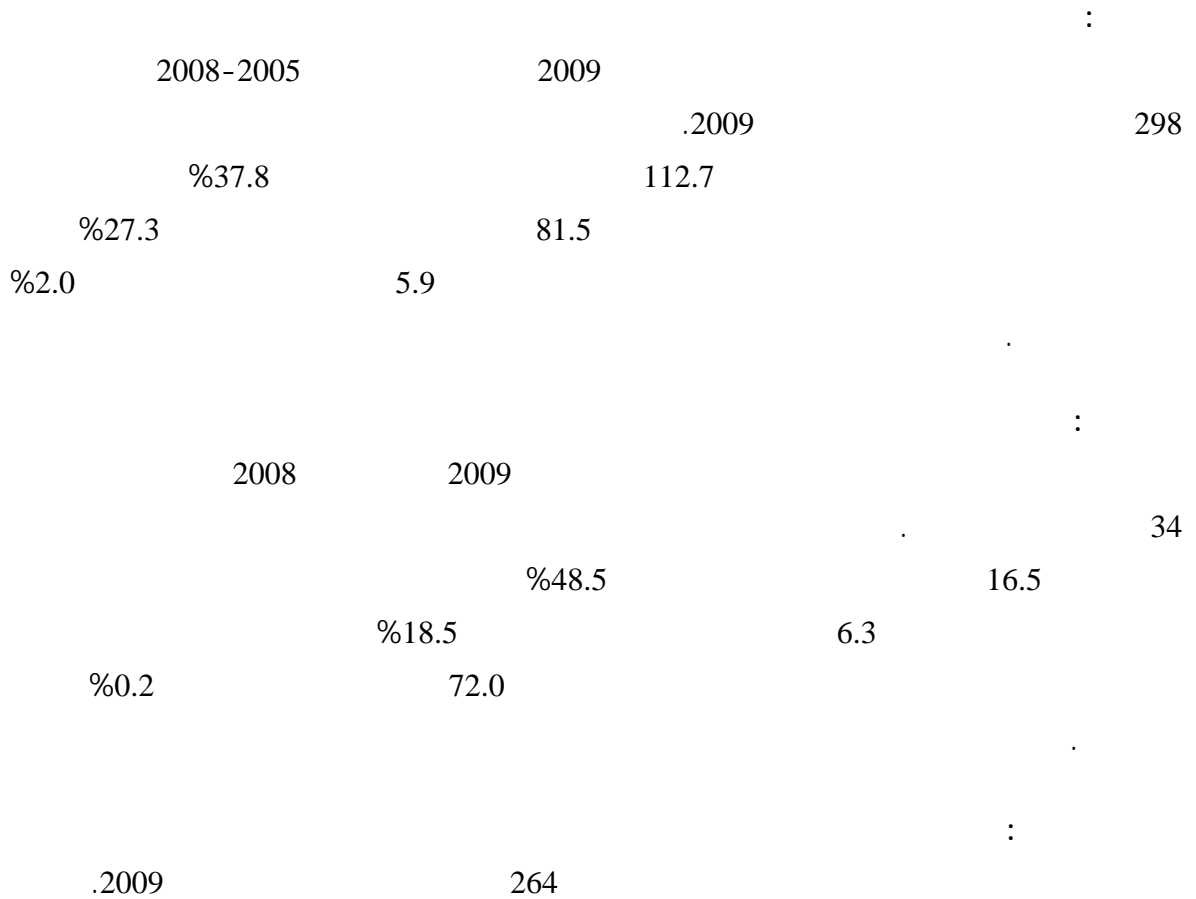

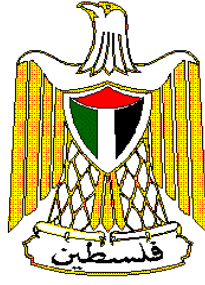

Executive Summary

PCBS presents this periodic statistical report about the reality of the Palestinian population in Tubas governorate as part of its policy to shed light on the status of Palestinian population in the different governorates in the Palestinian Territory. These are the most prominent findings:

- Estimated population in Tubas governorate totaled 56,642 person at mid 2011 including 28,774 males and 27,868 females. About 15.6% of the total population of Tubas governorate are refugees at end year 2007.
- Number of registered marriage certificates at Shariah and church courts during 2010 in Tubas governorate totaled 508. The number of registered divorce cases at Shariah and church courts totaled 73.
- Number of registered live births in 2010 in Tubas governorate totaled 1,140 birth. Number of registered deaths in the governorate for the same year totaled 138.
- The Participation Rate of labor force (aged 15 years and above) in 2010 in Tubas governorate is 46.3%. Unemployed persons constitutes about 11.8% of those participating in labor force.
- There were 40 schools and 29 kindergartens in Tubas governorate in 2009/2010 .
- The area of lands in Tubas governorate in 2010 was 402 square kilometers.
- Number of Agricultural Holdings in Tubas Governorate reached 2,917 during the agricultural year 2009/2010.
- Number of inhabited houses in Tubas governorate totaled 8,628 in 2007.
- Number of building licenses in Tubas governorate in 2010 totaled 322 license for an area of 74.4 thousand square meters.
- Water networks are main source of water for 10 localities in Tubas governorate compared with 11 localities without water networks. Electricity network are main source of electricity for 15 localities compared with 6 localities without electricity network.
- Number of licensed vehicles in 2009 in Jenin and Tubas governorates was 14,085 vehicle.
- The values of imports rose in Jenin and Tubas governorates in 2009 compared to 2005–2008, reaching about 298 million US\$.
- Exports in Jenin and Tubas governorates in 2009 fall, in comparison with year 2008, reaching 34 million US\$.
- There was deficit in the trade balance of Jenin and Tubas governorates in 2009 totaling 264 million US\$.
