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

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
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Figure 1: Estimated Population in Jenin Governorate at Mid-Year, 1997, 2007-2011


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
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Figure 3: Distribution of Primary Health Care Clinics and Centers in Jenin Governorate by Supervising Authority, 2004-2008










Figure 4: Percentage Distribution of Population(15 Years and Above) in Jenin Governorate by Labor Force Status, 2005-2010



15) Figure 5: Percentage Distribution of Population (15 Years and Above) in Jenin **Governorate by Labor Force Components, 2010** 








Figure 6: Number of Schools in Jenin Governorate by Stage and Supervising Authority, 2009/2010

Figure 7: Number of Students in Schools in Jenin Governorate by Stage and Supervising Authority, 2009/2010



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

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

Figure 9: Percentage Distribution of Households by Type of Housing Unit in Jenin Governorate, 2010











Figure 10: Issued Building Licenses in Jenin Governorate by Quarter, 2010

Figure 11: Issued Building Licenses in Jenin Governorate by Area & Quarter, 2010



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# **Executive Summary**

PCBS presents this periodic statistical report about the reality of the Palestinian population in Jenin governorate as part of its policy to shed light on the status of Palestinian population in the different governorates in the Palestinian Territory. These are the most prominent findings:

- Estimated population in Jenin governorate totaled 281,156 person at mid 2011 including 142,827 males and 138,329 females. About 32.8% of the total population of Jenin governorate are refugees at end year 2007.
- Number of registered marriage certificates at Shariah and church courts during 2010 in Jenin governorate totaled 2,696. The number of registered divorce cases at Shariah and church courts totaled 386.
- Number of registered live births in 2010 in Jenin governorate totaled 7,295 birth. Number of registered deaths in the governorate for the same year totaled 845.
- Number of hospitals in 2009 in Jenin Governorate was 3 hospitals. Number of hospital beds totaled 160 with bed occupancy rate of 0.6 per 1000 people.
- The Participation Rate of labor force (aged 15 years and above) in 2010 in Jenin governorate was 42.6%. Unemployed persons constitutes about 15.4% of those participating in labor force.
- There were 236 schools and 83 kindergartens in Jenin governorate in 2009/2010.
- The area of lands in Jenin governorate in 2010 was 583 square kilometers.
- Number of Agricultural Holdings in Jenin governorate reached 14,514 during the agricultural year 2009/2010.
- Number of inhabited houses in Jenin governorate totaled 46,541 in 2007.
- Number of building licenses in Jenin governorate in 2010 totaled 483 license for an area of 156.4 thousand square meters.
- Water networks are main source of water for 52 localities in Jenin governorate compared with 28 localities without water networks. Electricity network are main source of electricity for 79 localities compared with 1 locality without electricity Network.
- Number of licensed vehicles in 2009 in Jenin and Tubas governorates was 14,085 vehicle.
- The values of imports rose in Jenin and Tubas governorates in 2009 compared to 2005–2008, reaching about 298 million US\$.
- Exports in Jenin and Tubas governorates in 2009 fall, in comparison with year 2008, reaching 34 million US\$.
- There was deficit in the trade balance of Jenin and Tubas governorates in 2009 totaling 264 million US\$.

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
