





Figure 3: Distribution of Primary Health Care Clinics and Centers in Tulkarm Governorate by Supervising Authority, 2004-2008








Figure 4: Percentage Distribution of Population(15 Years and Above) in Tulkarm Governorate by Labor Force Status, 2005-2010








Figure 5: Percentage Distribution of Population (15 Years and Above) in Tulkarm Governorate by Labor Force Components, 2010

Map 2: Percentage Distribution of Population (15 Years and Above) in Tulkarm Governorate and West Bank by Sex and Labor Force Components, 2010.








Figure 6: Number of Schools in Tulkarm Governorate by Stage and Supervising Authority, 2009/2010

Figure 7: Number of Students in Schools in Tulkarm Governorate by Stage and Supervising Authority, 2009/2010









Executive Summary

PCBS presents this periodic statistical report about the reality of the Palestinian population in Tulkarm governorate as part of its policy to shed light on the status of Palestinian population in the different governorates in the Palestinian Territory. These are the most prominent findings:

- Estimated population in Tulkarm governorate totaled 168,973 person at mid 2011 including 85,332 males and 83,641 females. About 33.6% of the total population of Tulkarm governorate are refugees at end year 2007.
- Number of registered marriage certificates at Shariah and church courts during 2010 in Tulkarm governorate totaled 1,484. The number of registered divorce cases at Shariah and church courts totaled 260.
- Number of registered live births in 2010 in Tulkarm governorate totaled 4,496 birth. Number of registered deaths in the governorate for the same year totaled 561.
- Number of hospitals in 2009 in Tulkarm Governorate was 3 hospitals. Number of hospital beds totaled 163 with bed occupancy rate of 1.0 per 1000 people.
- The Participation Rate of labor force (aged 15 years and above) in 2010 in Tulkarm governorate was 43.2%. Unemployed persons constitute about 13.7% of those participating in labor force.
- There were 144 schools and 50 kindergartens in Tulkarm governorate in 2009/2010.
- The area of lands in Tulkarm governorate in 2010 was 246 square kilometers.
- Number of Agricultural Holdings in Tulkarm governorate reached 8,147 during the agricultural year 2009/2010.
- 10.9% of the individuals are poor in Tulkarm governorate in 2010.
- Number of building licenses in Tulkarm governorate in 2010 totaled 641 license for an area of 208.3 thousand square meters.
- Water networks are main source of water for 33 localities in Tulkarm governorate compared with 2 localities without water networks. Electricity network are main source of electricity for 35 localities.
- Number of licensed vehicles in 2009 in Tulkarm governorate was 11,257 vehicle.
- The values of imports rose in Tulkarm governorate in 2009 compared to 2005-2008, reaching about 152.6 million US\$.
- Exports in Tulkarm governorate in 2009 fall, in comparison with years 2006-2008, reaching 8.4 million US\$.
- There was deficit in the trade balance of Tulkarm governorate in 2009 totaling 144.2 million US\$.
