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Executive Summary

PCBS presents this periodic statistical report about the reality of the Palestinian population in Qalqiliya governorate as part of its policy to shed light on the status of Palestinian population in the different governorates in the Palestinian Territory. These are the most prominent findings:

- Estimated population in Qalqiliya governorate totaled 100,012 person at mid 2011 including 51,306 males and 48,706 females.
- About 47.0% of the total population of Qalqiliya governorate are refugees at end year 2007.
- Number of registered marriage certificates at Shariah and church courts during 2010 in Qalqiliya governorate totaled 892. The number of registered divorce cases at Shariah and church courts totaled 176.
- Number of registered live births in 2010 in Qalqiliya governorate totaled 3,167 birth. Number of registered deaths in the governorate for the same year totaled 269.
- Number of hospitals in 2010 in Qalqiliya Governorate was 3 hospitals. Number of hospital beds totaled 163 with bed occupancy rate of 1.4 per 1000 people.
- The Participation Rate of labor force (Aged 15 Years and Above) in 2010 in Qalqiliya governorate was 42.5% from Total blessing the strength human in Qalqiliya governorate. Unemployed persons constitute about 19.8% of those participating in labor force.
- 4.7% of the individuals are poor in Qalqiliya governorate in 2010.
- There were 85 schools and 35 kindergartens in Qalqiliya governorate in 2009/2010.
- The area of lands in Qalqiliya governorate in 2010 was 166 square kilometers.
- Number of Agricultural Holdings in Qalqiliya governorate reached 4,823 during the agricultural year 2009/2010.
- Number of building licenses in Qalqiliya governorate in 2010 totaled 344 license for an area of 87.9 thousand square meters.
- Water networks are main source of water for 30 localities in Qalqiliya governorate, compared with 4 localities without water networks. Electricity network are main source of electricity for 30 localities, compared with 4 localities without electricity network in 2010.
- Number of licensed vehicles in 2010 in Qalqiliya governorate was 3,925 vehicle.
- The values of imports fall in Qalqiliya governorate in 2009 compared to 2008, reaching about 79 million US\$.
- Exports in Qalqiliya governorate in 2009 rose compared to 2008, reaching 19.2 million US\$.
- There was deficit in the trade balance of Qalqiliya governorate in 2009 totaling 59.8 million US\$.

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
