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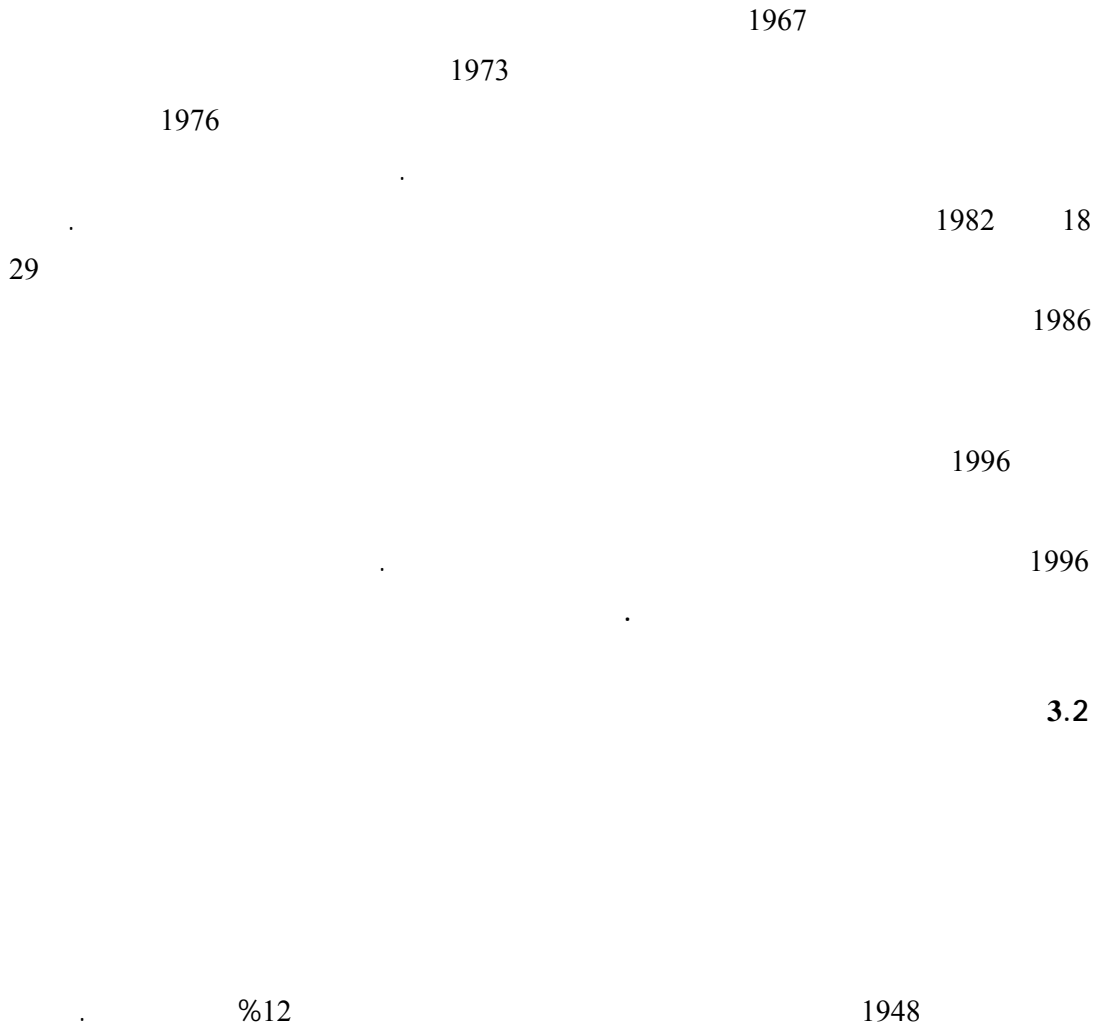

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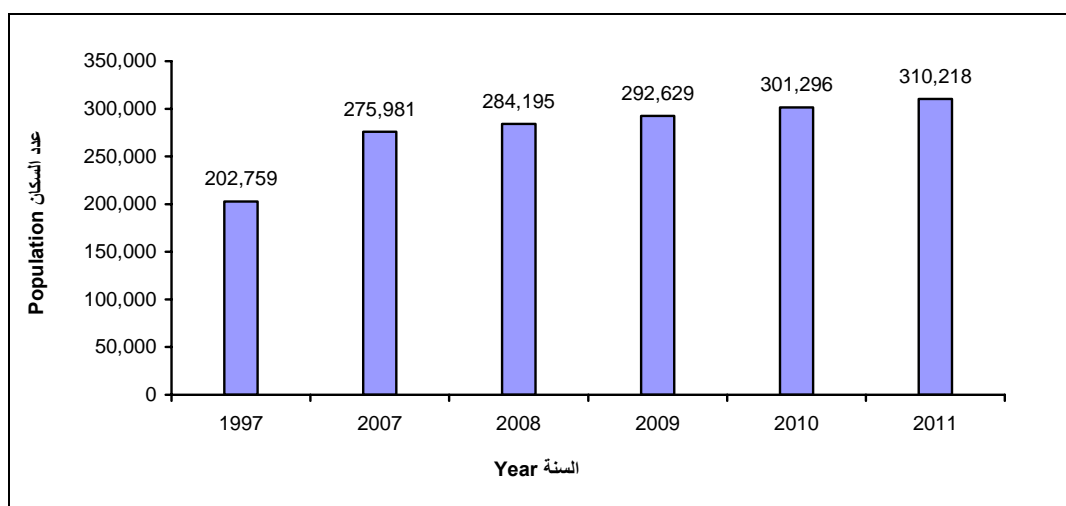

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Figure 1: Estimated Population in Ramallah & Al Bireh Governorate at Mid-Year, 1997, 2007-2011



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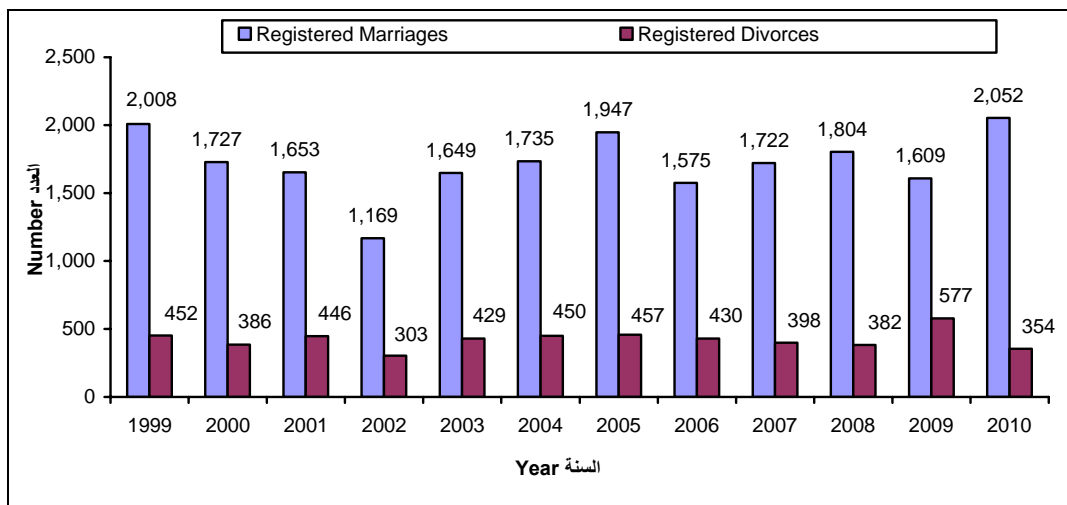

Figure 2: Registered Marriages and Divorces in Shariah and Church Courts in Ramallah & Al Bireh Governorate, 1999-2010



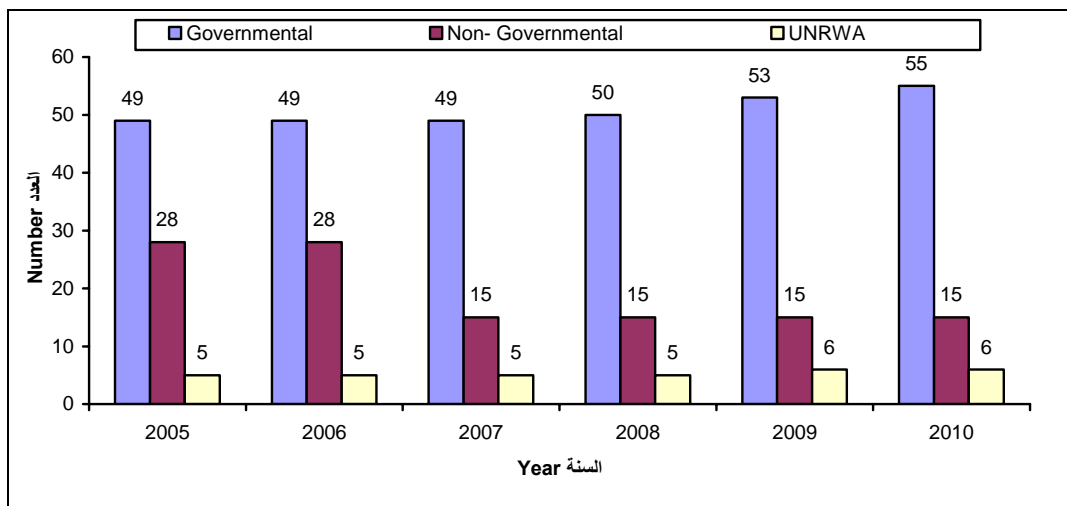

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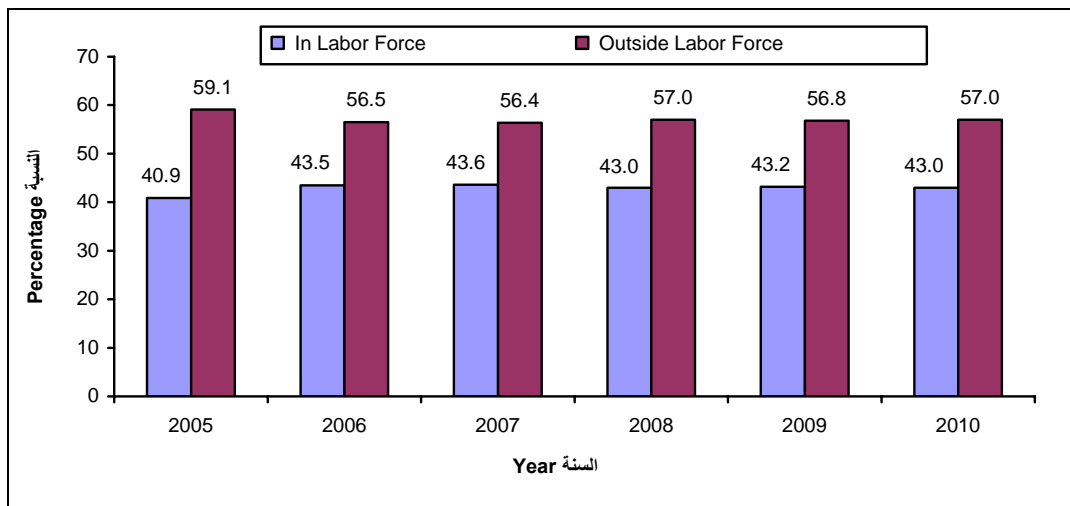

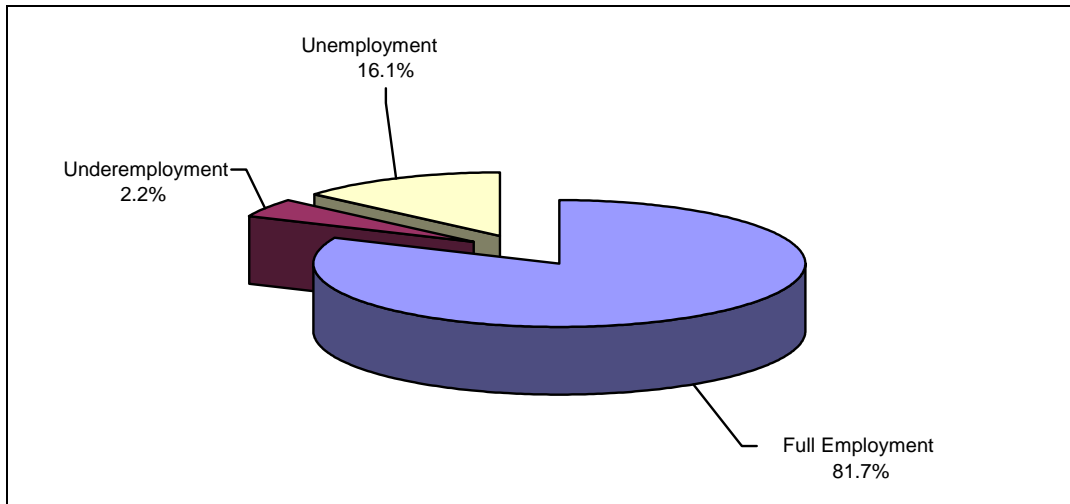

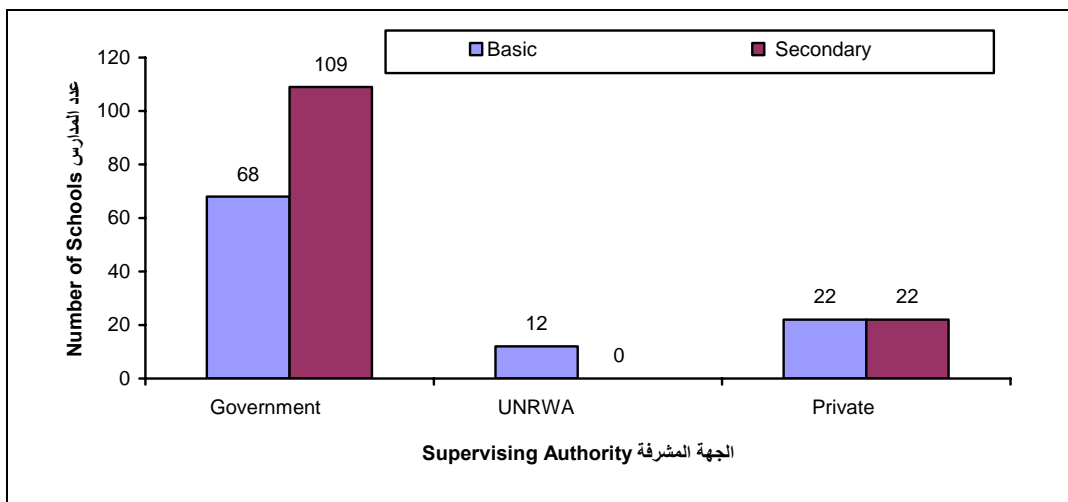

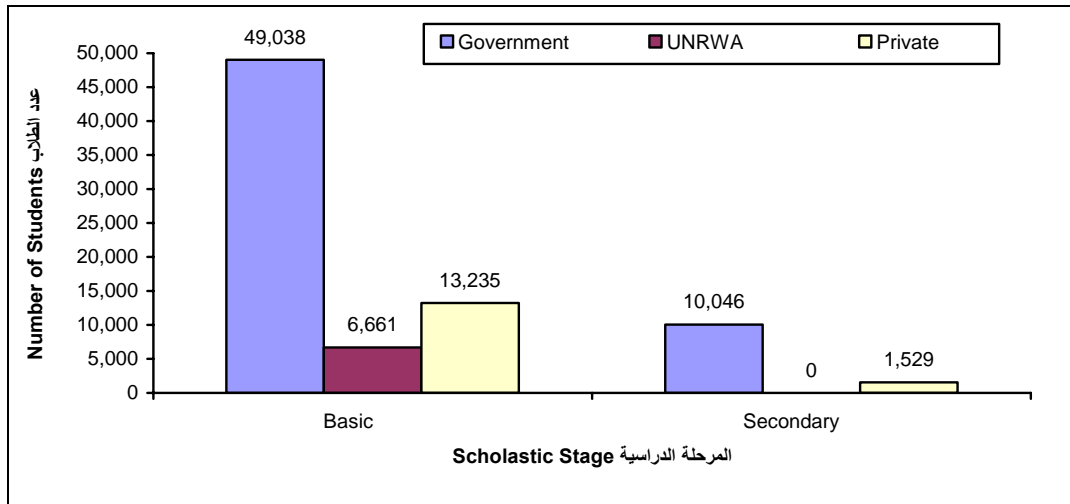
Figure 6: Number of Schools in Ramallah & Al Bireh Governorate by Stage and Supervising Authority, 2010/2011

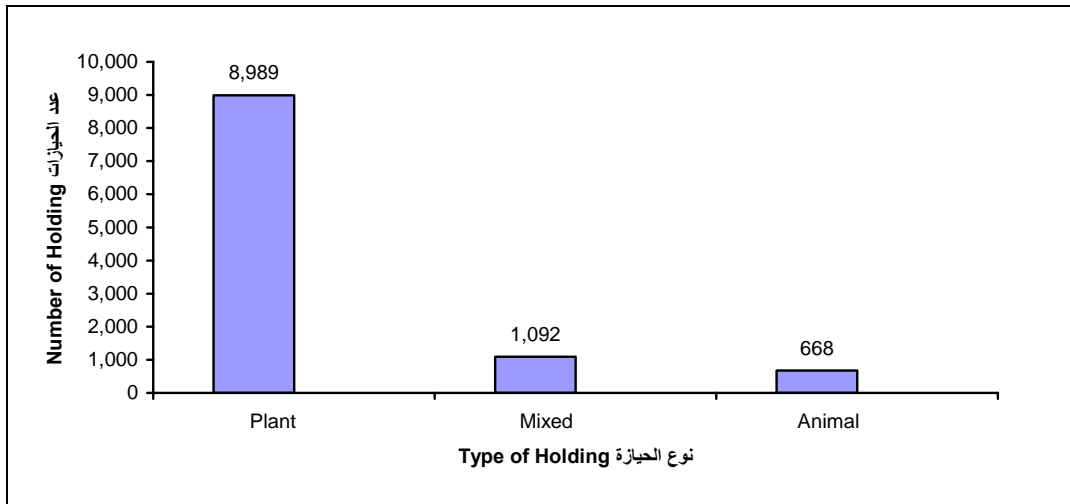

Figure 8: Number of Agricultural Holdings in Ramallah & Al Bireh Governorate by Type of Holding, 2009/2010

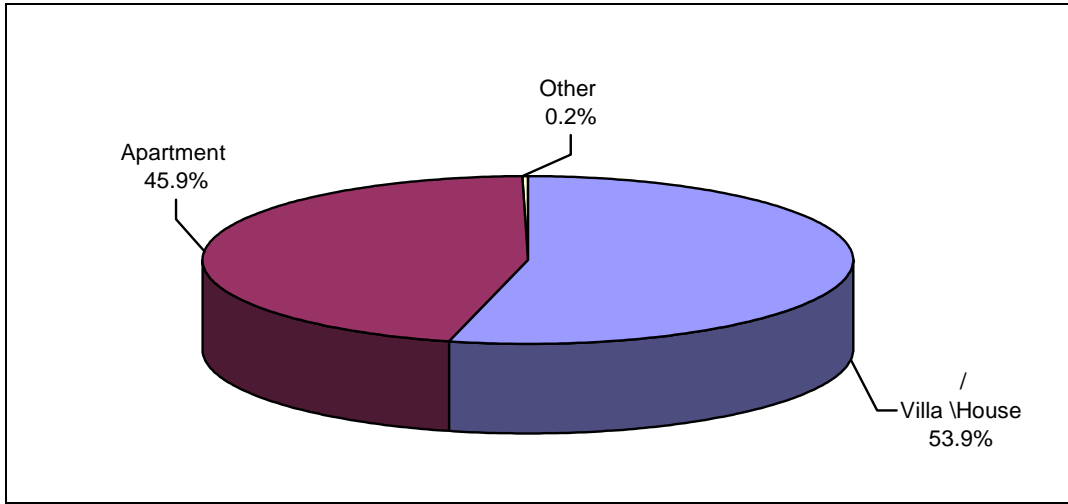

Figure 9: Percentage Distribution of Households in Ramallah & Al Bireh Governorate by Type of Housing Unit, 2010



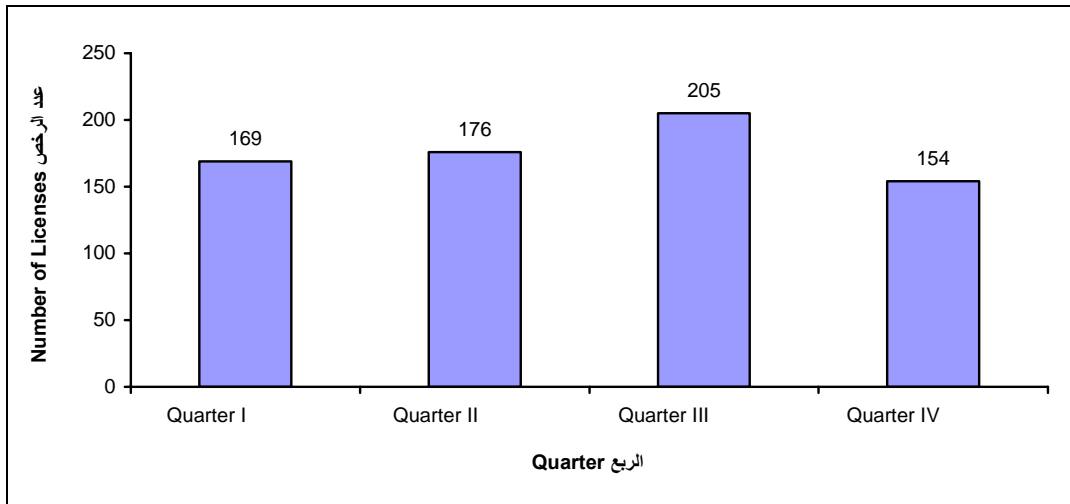

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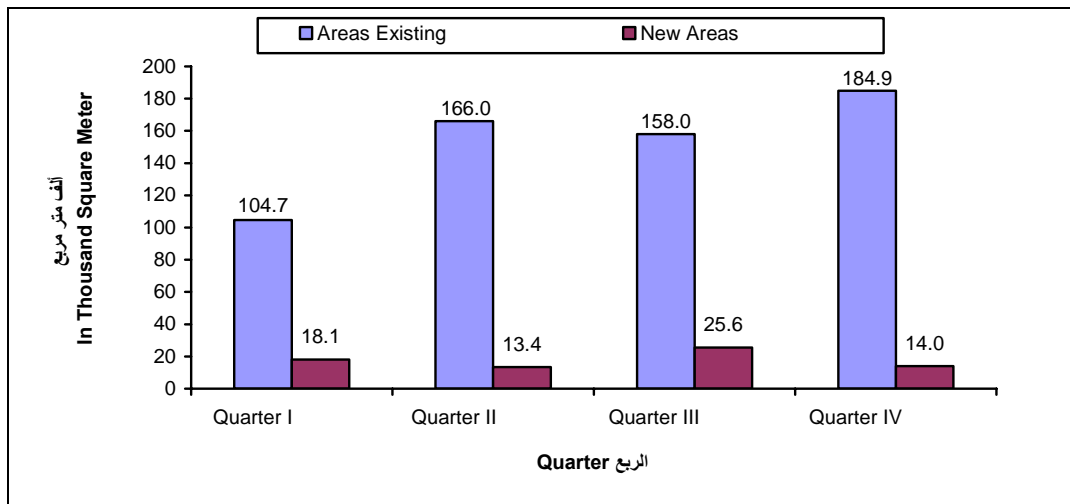
Figure 10: Number of Issued Building Licenses in Ramallah & Al Bireh Governorate by Quarter, 2010

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Figure 11: Licensed Area for Building in Ramallah & Al Bireh Governorate by Area Type and Quarter, 2010



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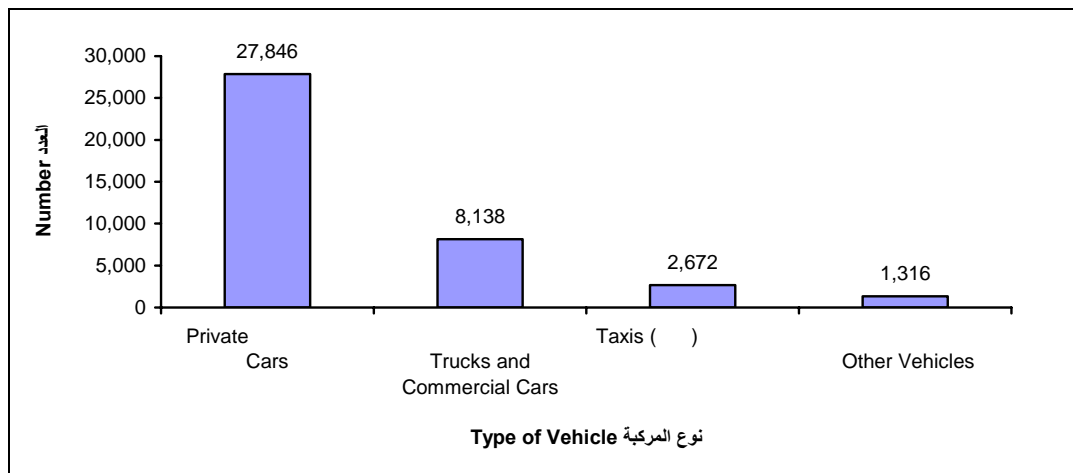

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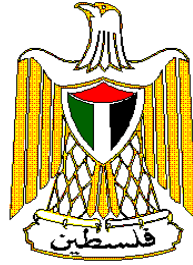

Executive Summary

PCBS presents this periodic statistical report about the reality of the Palestinian population in Ramallah & Al Bireh governorate as part of its policy to shed light on the status of Palestinian population in the different governorates in the Palestinian Territory. These are the most prominent findings:

- Estimated population in Ramallah & Al Bireh governorate totaled 310,218 person at mid 2011 including 156,039 males and 154,179 females. About 29.3% of the total population of Ramallah & Al Bireh governorate are refugees at end year 2007.
- Number of registered marriage certificates at shariah and church courts during 2010 in Ramallah & Al Bireh governorate totaled 2,052. The number of registered divorce cases at Shariah courts totaled 354.
- Number of registered live births in 2010 in Ramallah & Al Bireh governorate totaled 7,495 birth. Number of registered deaths in the governorate for the same year totaled 728.
- Number of hospitals in 2010 in Ramallah & Al Bireh governorate was 8 hospitals. Number of hospital beds totaled 318 with bed occupancy rate of 1.16 per 1000 people.
- The participation rate of labor force (aged 15 years and above) in 2010 in Ramallah & Al Bireh governorate was 43.0% from total of human power. Unemployed persons constitute about 16.1% of those participating in labor force.
- 11.7% of the individuals are poor in Ramallah & Al Bireh governorate in 2010.
- There were 233 schools and 67 kindergartens in Ramallah & Al Bireh governorate in 2010/2011.
- The area of lands in Ramallah & Al Bireh governorate in 2010 was 855 square kilometers.
- Number of agricultural holdings in Ramallah & Al Bireh governorate reached 10,749 during the agricultural year 2009/2010.
- Number of building licenses in Ramallah & Al Bireh governorate in 2010 totaled 704 license for an area of 684.7 thousand square meters.
- Water networks are main source of water for 74 localities in Ramallah & Al Bireh governorate compared with 1 locality without water network. Electricity network are main source of electricity for 74 localities compared with 1 locality without electricity network.
- Number of licensed vehicles in 2010 in Ramallah & Al Bireh governorate was 39,972 vehicle.
- The values of imports increased in Ramallah & Al Bireh governorates in 2009 compared to 2008, reaching about 1,110.9 million US\$.
- Exports in Ramallah & Al Bireh governorate in 2009 decreased, in comparison with year 2008, reaching 102.3 million US\$.
- There was deficit in the trade balance of Ramallah & Al Bireh governorate in 2009 totaling 1,008.6 million US\$.

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
