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




Estimated Population in Palestine by Governorate, 2018


Percentage Distribution of Palestinians in the World by Country of Residence, End Year 2018

Population in Palestine by Region and Sex, End Year 2018




Registered Live Births and Deaths in Palestine by Region, Governorate and Sex, 2016, 2017

Population Pyramid in Palestine, Mid-Year 2018





Palestinian Population (14 Years and Above) in Palestine by Region, Marital Status and Sex, 2017


Crude Marriage and Divorce Rate (Per 1000) of Population for Registered Cases at Shari'a Courts and Churches in Palestine by Governorate, 2017






Unemployment Rate of Participants in the Labour Force (15 Years and Above) by Sex and Years of Schooling in Palestine, 2015-2018


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

Percentage Distribution of Monthly Household Consumption in Jordanian Dinars (JD) in Palestine by Commodities, Service Groups and Region, 2017




Individual Poverty Rates According to Household Consumption in Palestine by Region, 2017







Percentage Distribution of Persons aged (15 Years and Over) in Palestine by Educational Attainment, 2018



Enrollment Rate of Palestinian Population Aged (6 Years and Over) in Palestine by Selected Age Groups and Sex, 2017



Percent of Households in Palestine by Availability of Internet at Home and Governorate, 2017







Physicians, and Beds per 1000 Population in Palestine, 2005-2017










Number of Reported Criminal Offenses in the West Bank* by Governorate, 2017







Percentage Distribution of Guest Nights in the West Bank by Nationality, 2017
















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




