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

- Agricultural Year: starts in October of every year and ends in September of the following year.

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








#### Registered Live Births and Deaths in Palestine\* by Governorate ,2019







Average Household Size in Palestine by Region, 2020






### Unemployment Rate of Participants in Labour Force (15 Years and over) in Palestine by Age Groups, 2020

### Percentage Distribution of Employed Persons (15 Years and over) in Palestine by Place of Work, 2017-2020







### Percentage Distribution of Persons aged (15 Years and over) in Palestine by Educational Attainment, 2019, 2020











#### Mortality Rates among Children Under-5 in Palestine, 2019-2020











## Quantity of Olives Pressed and Olive Oil Extracted in Palestine, 2017-2019



Number of Guest Nights in the West Bank by Nationality, 2019







Quantity of Water Available Annually in Palestine, 2009-2019
















