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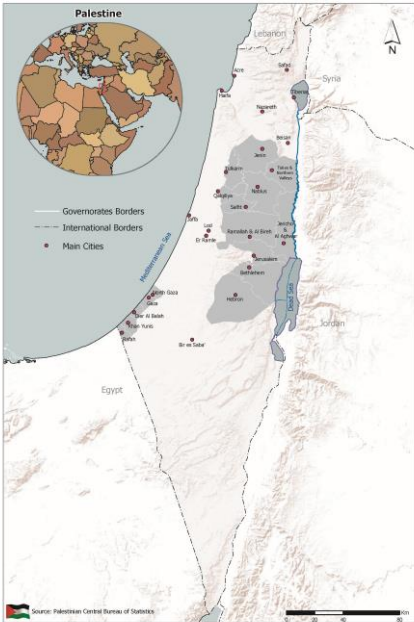

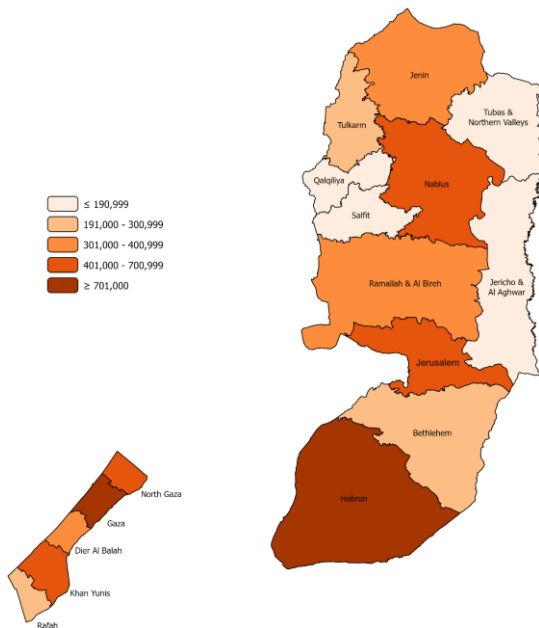

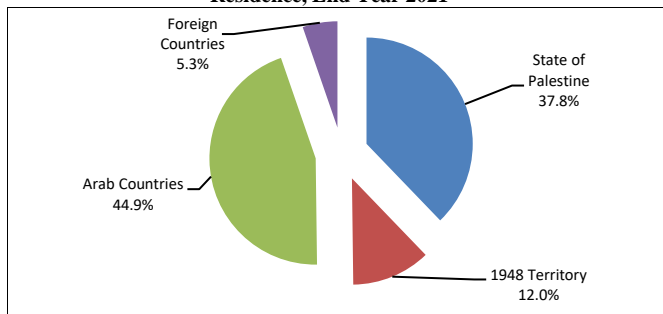
**Estimated Population in Palestine by Governorate, (Mid-Year 2021)**

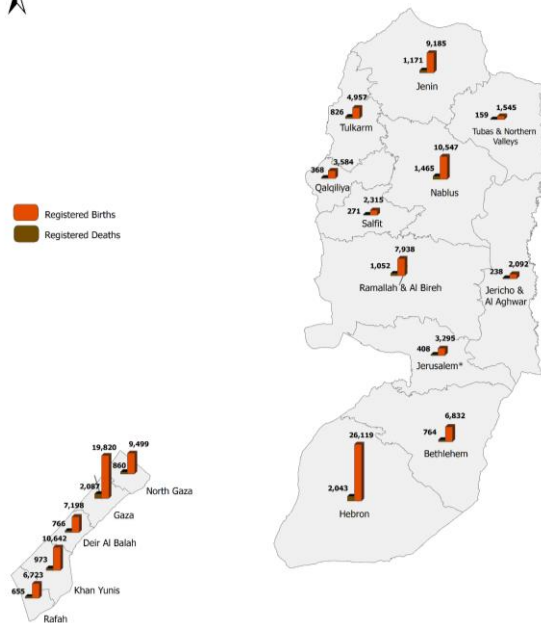

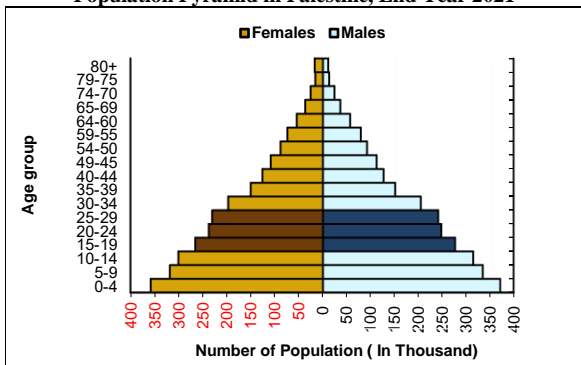

# Registered Live Births and Deaths in Palestine by Governorate, 2020

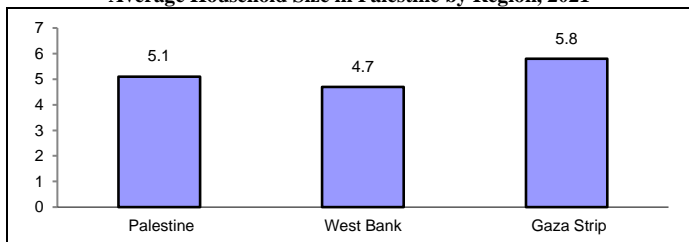

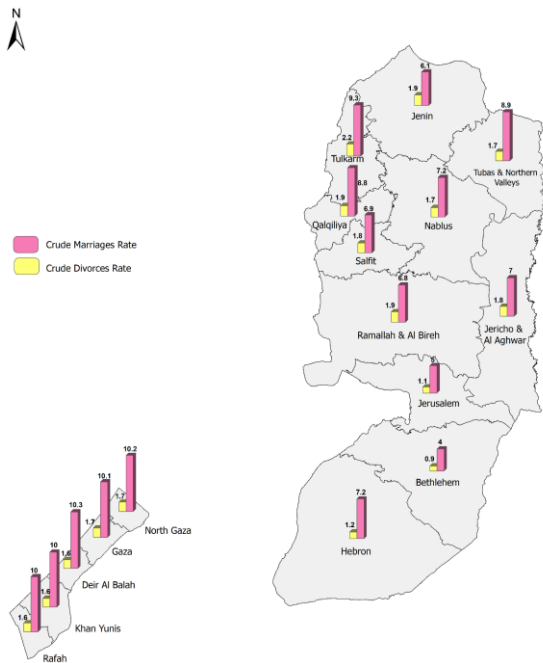

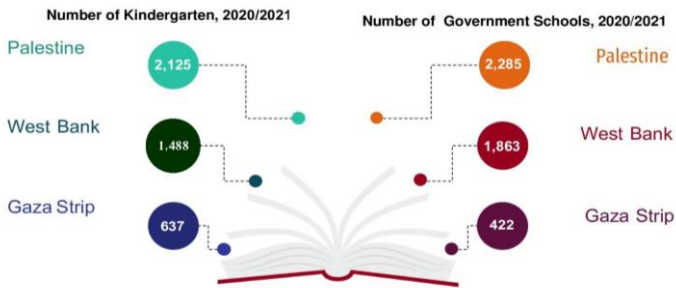

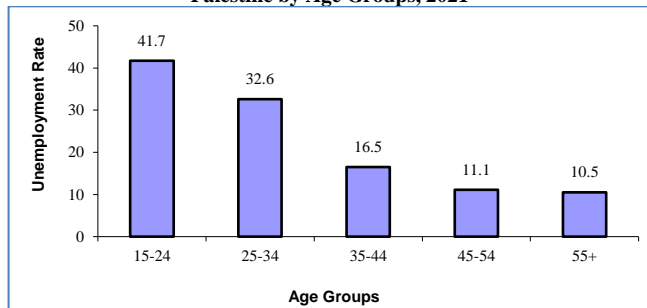

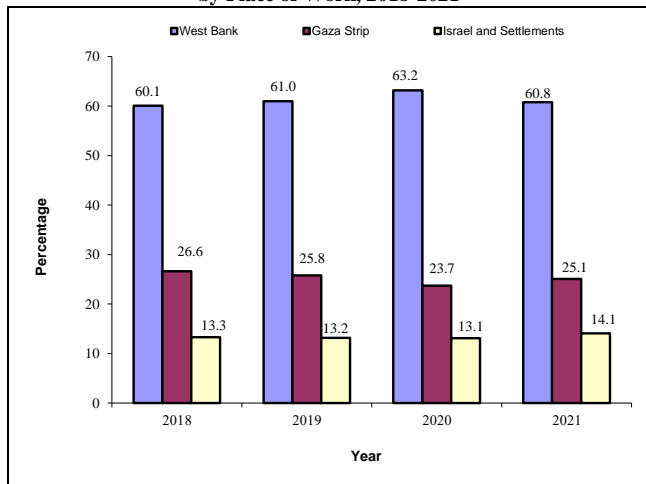
### Unemployment Rate of Participants in Labour Force (15 Years and over) in Palestine by Age Groups, 2021

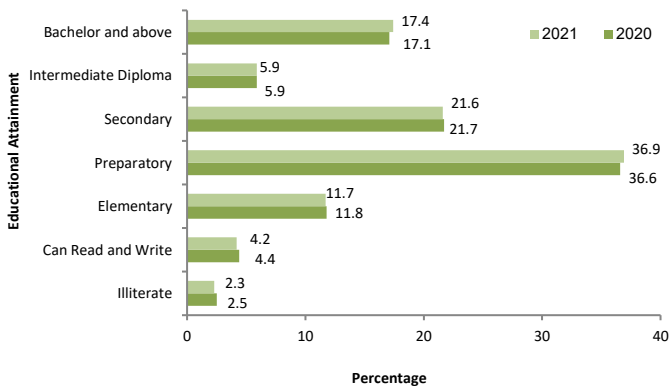

### Percentage Distribution of Persons aged (15 Years and over) in Palestine by Educational Attainment, 2020, 2021



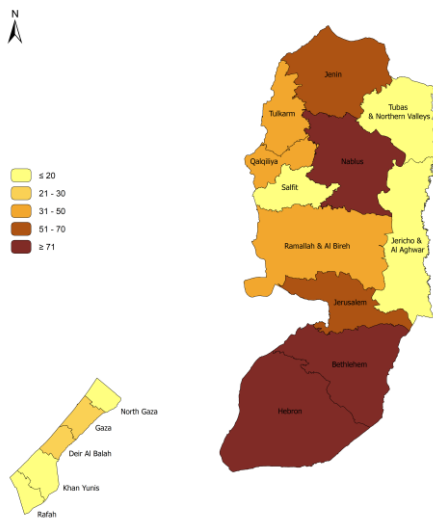

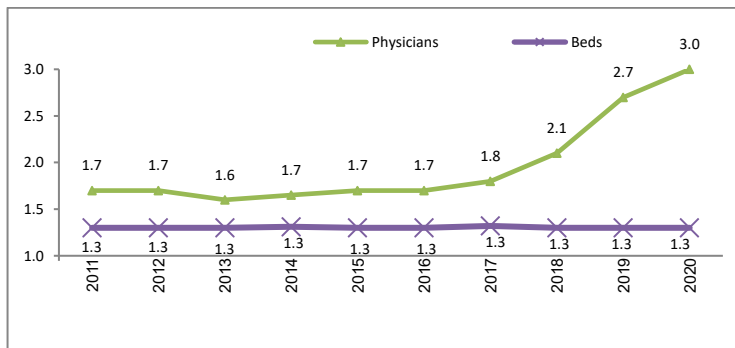

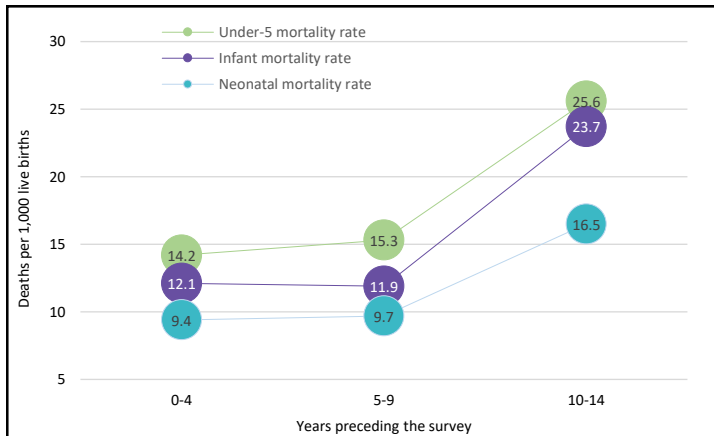

## Mortality Rates among Children Under-5, Infant and Neonatal in Palestine, 2019-2020

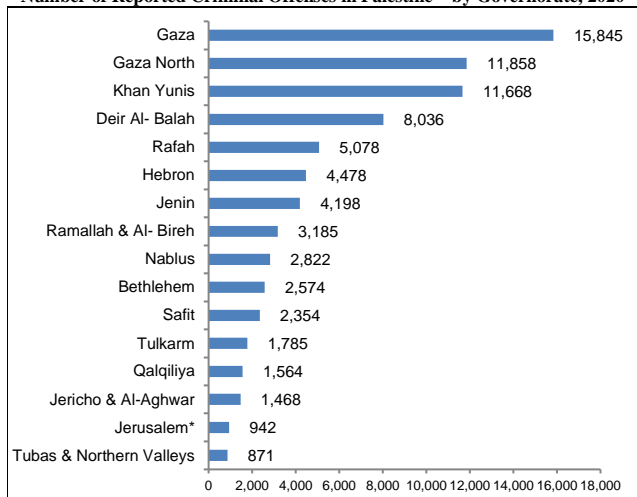

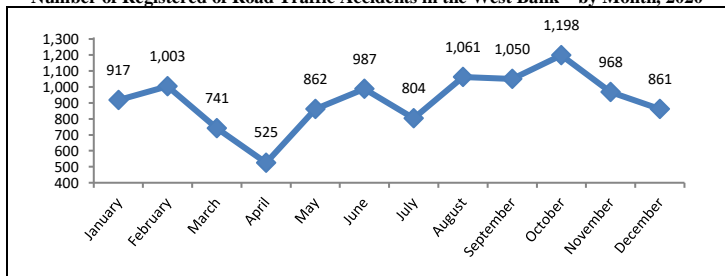

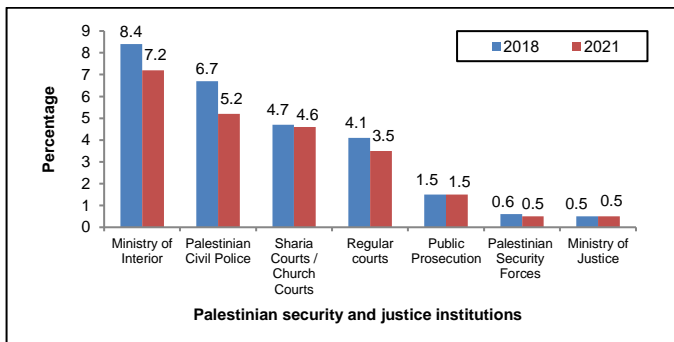

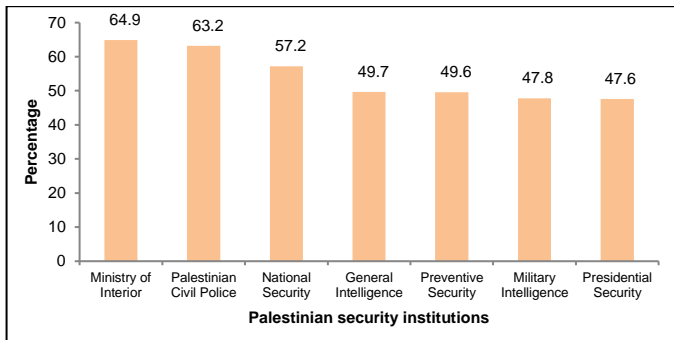

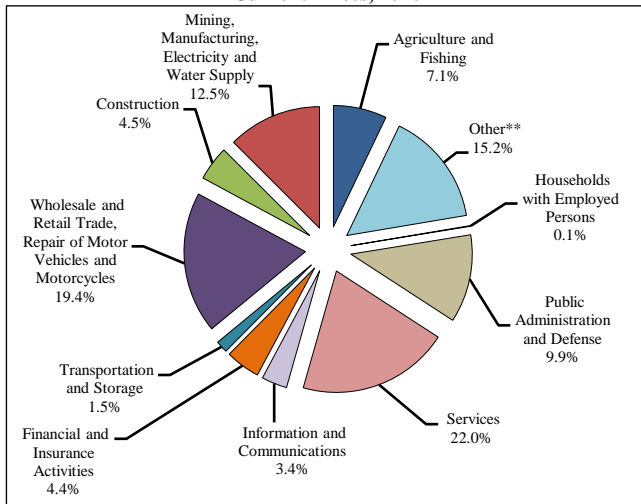

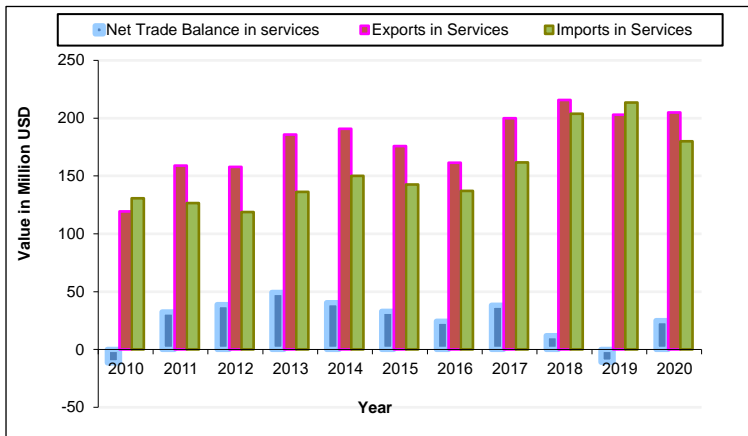

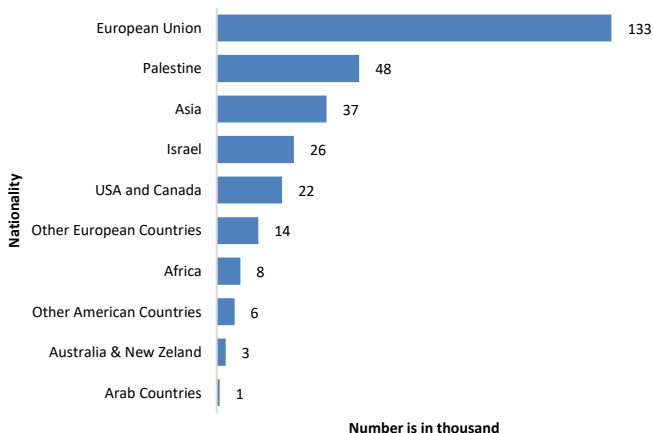

### Number of Guest Nights in the West Bank by Nationality, 2020

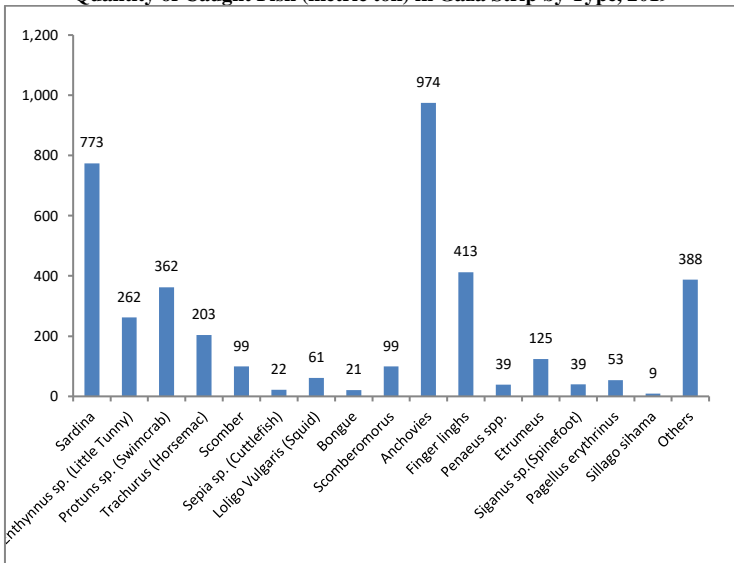

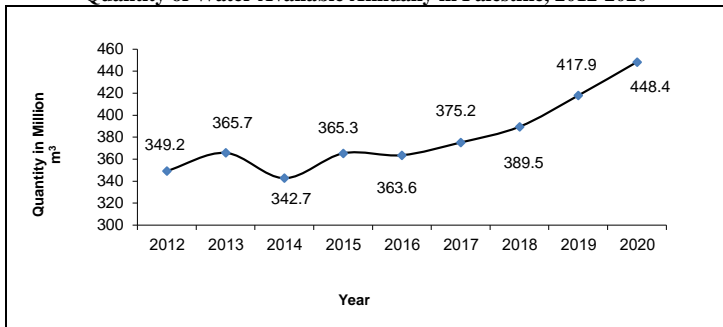

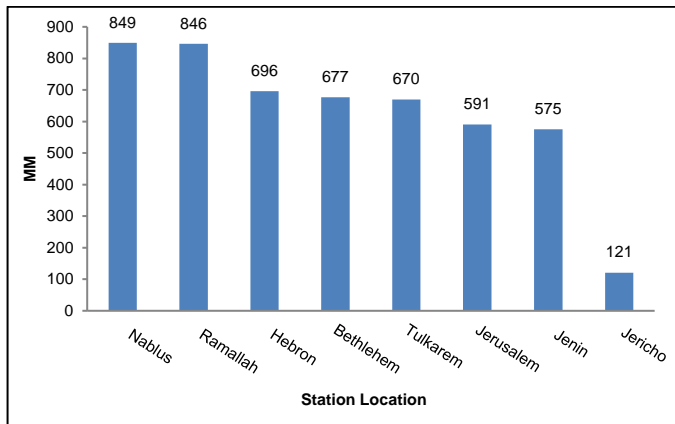

## Quantity of Water Available Annually in Palestine, 2012-2020

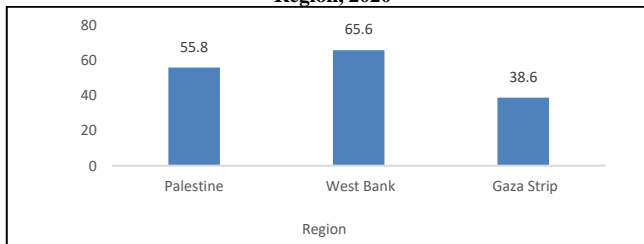

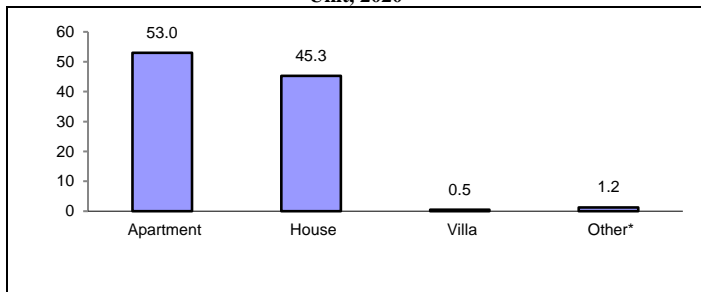

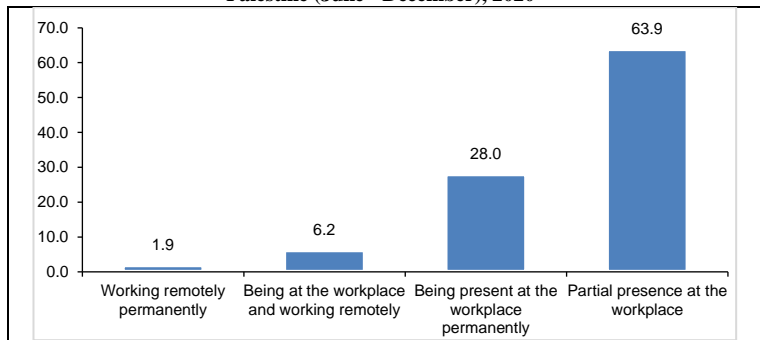

**Percentage Distribution of Main Income Earners by Region, Sex of the Household's Main Income Earner and the Reality of Work , Palestine (June - December), 2020**

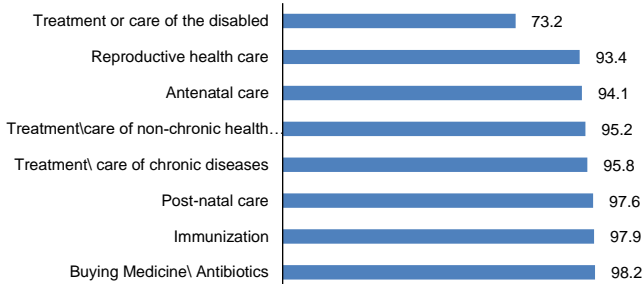


**Percentage Distribution of Main Income Earners by the Nature of Work, Palestine (June - December), 2020**

### Percentage of Households Who Needed Health Services and Managed to Reach them by Type of Health Service, Palestine (June - December), 2020



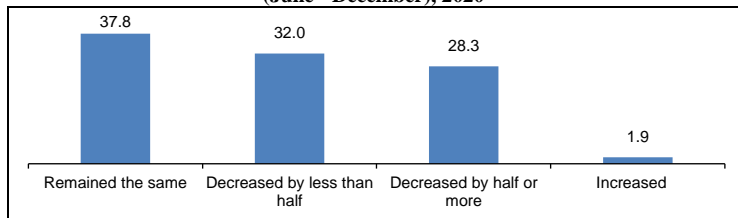

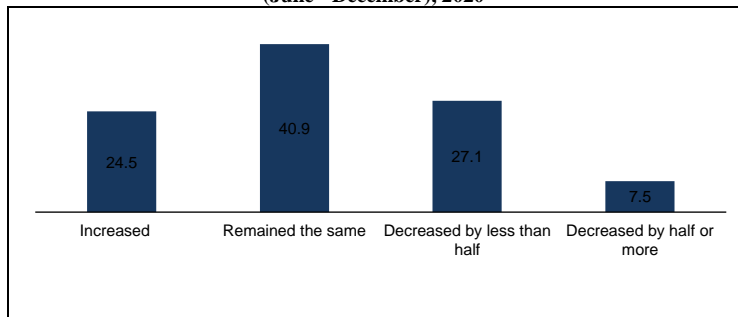


## 1.4 Food Security and COVID-19 Impact on Livelihoods

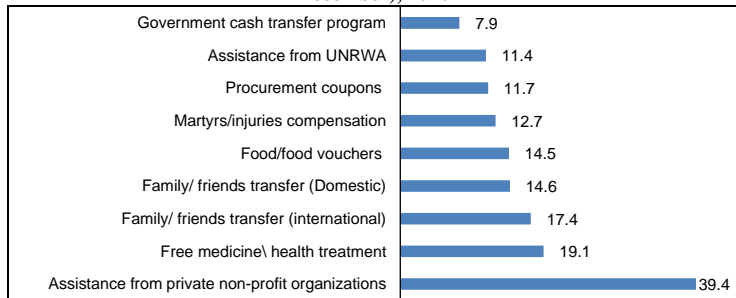

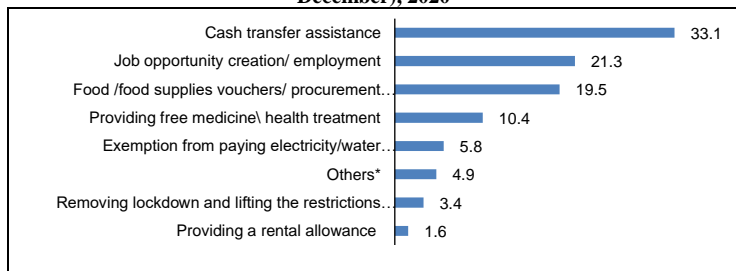

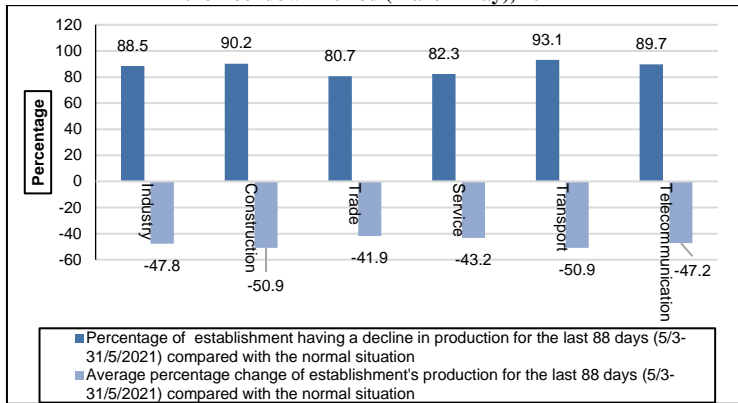
