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

- 4. Agricultural Year: starts in October of every year and ends in September of the following year.

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



Estimated Population in Palestine by Region and Sex, End Year 2022





Average Household Size in Palestine by Region, 2022






Crude Rate (Per 1000 population) for Registered Marriage and Divorce Cases at Shari'a Courts and Churches in Palestine by Governorate, 2021






Unemployment Rate of Participants in Labour Force (15 Years and over) in Palestine by Age Groups, 2022






Percentage Distribution of Employed Persons (15 Years and over) in Palestine by Place of Work, 2019-2022







Physicians, and Beds per 1000 Population in Palestine, 2011-2021








Percentage of Individuals (18 Years and above) in Palestine Who are Current Smokers of Various Smoked Tobacco Products, by Region, 2021

Percentage of Individuals (18 years and above) Who were Exposed to Secondhand Smoke by Place of Exposure and Region, 2021






















Percentage Distribution of the Imported Electricity in Palestine by Region, 2021

Percentage Distribution of the Number of Settlements in the West Bank by Governorate, 2021


