Palestinian Central Bureau of Statistics "PCBS" Release A Statistical Report about Agriculture Statistics in the Palestinian Territory, 2002\2003

1,815 Thousand Dunum Cultivated in the Palestinian Territory US\$ 416 Million the Value Added of the Agricultural Sector, 2002\2003

Palestinian Central Bureau of Statistics "PCBS" released a statistical data on agriculture statistics in the Palestinian Territory for the agricultural year 2002\2003, data reveal that the area cultivated with field crops, fruit trees, vegetables, and cut flowers in the Palestinian Territory amounted to 1,815 thousand dunum, compared with 1,851 thousand dunum in 2001/2002.

Fruit trees constituted 63.8% from the total cultivated area of the Palestinian Territory. While field crops and vegetables production comprised 26.6% and 9.6% of the cultivated Palestinian areas respectively; 70.2% of the cultivated area in Gaza Strip rely on irrigation compared with only 7.3% of the West Bank.

The livestock production was as follows: cattle, 33,235 in 2002/2003 and 30,105 in 2001/2002 with 10.4% increase, sheep, 828,678 in 2002/2003 compared with 758,293 in 2001/2002 with 9.3% increase, and goats, 392,122 in 2002/2003 compared with 355,387 in 2001/2002 with 10.3% increase. And 37,065 thousands broiler chickens, and 2,895 thousands layer chickens the number of chickens reported in 2002/2003.

The value added of agricultural production of the Palestinian Territory amounted to about US\$ 416 million which shows a decrease compared with 2001/2002 which amounted to US\$ 458 million. Plant production constituted 83.0% of the value added of agricultural production (of which 65.0% in the West Bank and 35.0% in Gaza Strip), while animal production constituted 17.0% (of which 72.1% in West Bank and 27.9% in Gaza Strip). The value of agricultural production of the Palestinian Territory amounted to about US\$ 856 million, of which 55.3% for plant production and 44.7% for Livestock production. The cost of intermediate consumption was about US\$ 441 millions, of which 29.2% of plant production and 70.8% of Livestock production .
