



The Annual Report on Transportation and Communication Statistics in the Palestinian Territory, 2010

Main Results

AN Increase in the Workers in the Transport, Storage and Communication Sector

The report results showed that the percentage total number of workers in the transport, storage and communication sector in 2010 was 6.0 percent compare to 5.7 percent in 2009

The Road Network Length in the Palestinian Territory

The results showed that the total paved road network length in the Palestinian Territory was 4,686.3 km at the end of 2010, out of which 4,389.3 km in the West Bank, 297.0 km in Gaza Strip.

Number of licensed Vehicles in the Palestinian Territory

The results show that the total number of licensed vehicles in the Palestinian Territory* was 182,466 at the end of 2010, out of which 66.6 percent in the West Bank*, and 33.4 percent in Gaza Strip.

The data shows that the private cars formed 63.9 percent of the total vehicles in the Palestinian Territory.

An Increase the Road Accidents and Casualties in the West Bank*

The results of the annual report showed that the number of road accidents in the West Bank* reached 5,408 in 2010, with an increase by 15.8 percent in comparison to 2009, The number of casualties in 2010 was 7,033 with an increase by 20.0 percent in comparison to 2009. Those Slightly injured formed 84.5 percent out of the total injured persons and the rate of fatality injured formed 1.9 percent compared to 2.1 percent of fatality injured in 2009.

A Decrease in the Number of Main Telephone Lines in the Palestinian Territory

The results showed that the total main telephone lines operating in the Palestinian territory 360.402 line by the end of 2010, with a decrease by 2.1 percent in comparison to 2009.

Number of Subscribers in the Cellular Phones

The results indicated that the number of subscribers in the Palestinian Cellular Phones by the end of the year 2010 in the Palestinian Territory 2.6 million subscribers.
