Palestinian Construction, Road, Water and Sewage Cost Index

Palestinian Central Bureau of Statistics (PCBS):

Water Networks Cost Index (WNCI) Decreased by 0.17%, Road Cost Index (RCI) decreased by 0.13%, and Construction Cost Index (CCI) Decreased by 0.09%, while Sewage Networks Cost Index (SNCI) Increased by 0.25% in the West Bank in September 2010 Compared with August 2010

The overall Water Networks Cost Index (WNCI) reached 103.15 in September 2010 in the West Bank with a decrease of 0.17% compared with August 2010 (base month January 2010=100), the overall Road Cost Index (RCI) reached 107.57 in September 2010 with a decrease of 0.13% compared with August 2010 (base month December 2008=100), and the overall Construction Cost Index (CCI) reached 109.53 in September 2010 with a decrease of 0.09% compared with August 2010 (base month December 2007=100), while the overall Sewage Networks Cost Index (SNCI) reached 103.01 in September 2010 with an increase of 0.25% compared with August 2010 (base month January 2010=100).

Analysis of Water Networks Cost Index developments for September indicates changes in the cost of the following major water networks inputs compared with the previous month:

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Analysis of Road Cost developments for September indicates changes in the cost of the following major road inputs compared with the previous month:

-	Iron and steel	- 1.20%
-	Asphalt and bitumen mixture and its products	- 0.87%
-	Cement products	- 0.20%
-	Electric wires and cables	+ 0.59%
-	Quarries and quarrying products	+ 0.45%

Analysis of Construction Cost developments for September indicates changes in the costs of the following major construction inputs compared with the previous month:

-	Iron and steel	- 0.67%
-	Cement products	- 0.28%
-	Cutting and shaping stones	+ 0.30%
-	Cement, lime & gypsum	+ 0.24%
-	Tiles and panels from ceramic	+ 0.16%
_	Quarries and quarrying products	+ 0.15%

Analysis of Sewage Networks Cost Index developments for September indicates changes in the cost of the following major sewage networks inputs compared with the previous month:

-	Fountains	+ 0.85%
-	Excavations	+ 0.55%
-	Deface materials	+ 0.29%
-	Asphalt, bitumen mixture and its products	- 0.83%
-	Plastic and cement pipes	- 0.38%

The data of West Bank doesn't cover those parts of Jerusalem which were annexed by Israel in 1967. **NB:**

- 1. Data of Gaza Strip is not available, due to the closure of PCBS' offices in Gaza Strip since 15/04/2008.
- 2. The difference in the percent change in major groups of Road, Construction, water networks, and sewage networks Cost Index is due to the nature compositions of these major groups.
