Palestinian Central Bureau Of Statistics (PCBS):

Construction Cost Index in the Remaining West Bank* declined by 0.33% in January 2009

The overall Construction Cost Index (CCI) for the Remaining West Bank* reached 107.29 in January 2009 compared with 107.64 during the previous month, (December 2007=100). Analysis of Construction Cost developments for January indicate a **decrease in** the cost of following major construction inputs:

-	Wood products	- 4.91 %
-	Building iron	- 3.32 %
-	Quarrying of stone and sand	- 2.36 %
-	Plastic products and health tools	- 1.68 %
-	Ceramic products	- 0.44 %
-	Equipment and electrical networking Aluminum and metal doors and windows	- 0.41 % - 0.38 %

At the same time, there was an **increase in the cost of** the following major groups:

-	Wages and labor cost	+ 1.69 %
-	Metals Tools	+ 1.42 %
-	Tiles and Panels from Ceramic	+ 0.97 %
-	Cutting and shaping stones	+ 0.41 %

* Remaining West Bank: Means West bank except those parts of Jerusalem, which were annexed by Israel in1967
