Palestinian Consumer Price Index declines 0.40% in February 2007

The overall Consumer Price Index (CPI) for the Palestinian Territory with its 1996 base year (1996=100) reached 153.42 in February 2007, a 0.40% decrease relative to January 2007.

Analysis of consumer price developments for February indicates **declines in** the following major expenditure groups:

-	Transport and Communications:	- 0.91 %
-	Food:	- 0.63 %
-	Housing:	- 0.19 %
-	Textiles, Clothing and Footwear:	- 0.03 %
-	Recreational, Cultural Goods and Services:	- 0.03 %
-	Medical Care:	- 0.03 %

At the same time, there were **increases** in other major expenditure groups including:

-	Miscellaneous Goods and Services:	+ 0.10 %
-	Furniture, Household Goods and Services:	+ 0.07 %
-	Beverages and Tobacco:	+ 0.01 %

Palestinian Territory regions experienced different overall CPI developments as follows:

-	Remaining West Bank:	- 0.46%
-	Gaza Strip:	- 0.13%
-	Jerusalem:	0.00%
