Palestinian Consumer Price Index Increases 3.76% in 2006

The overall Consumer Price Index (CPI) for the Palestinian Territory with its 1996 base year (1996=100) reached 152.31 in 2006, a 3.76% increase relative to 2005.

Analysis of consumer price developments for 2006 indicates **increases** in the following major expenditure groups:

-	Miscellaneous Goods and Services:	+ 5.60 %
-	Transport and Communications:	+ 5.57 %
-	Food:	+ 4.86 %
-	Beverages and Tobacco:	+ 3.29 %
-	Housing:	+ 3.27 %
-	Education:	+1.55 %
-	Medical Care:	+ 1.51 %
-	Furniture, Household Goods and Services:	+ 1.40 %
-	Textiles, clothing and footwear:	+ 0.64 %

At the same time, there were **declines** in other major expenditure groups including:

- Recreational, Cultural Goods and Services: - 0.96 %

Palestinian Territory regions experienced different overall CPI developments as follows:

-	Gaza Strip:	+ 5.09%
-	Remaining West Bank:	+ 4.00%
-	Jerusalem:	+ 3.04%
