Stability in the CPI

The overall Consumer Price Index (CPI) for the Palestinian Territory with its 2004 base year (2004=100) reached 132.02 in March 2011. The CPI decreased by 0.05% compared with February 2011 and increased by 3.59% compared with March 2010.

The decrease in the Consumer Price Index for March is traced to changes in the prices of the following major Expenditure Groups compared with the previous month:
