Palestinian Central Bureau of Statistics (PCBS):

Palestinian Consumer Price Index Increased by 1.39% in September 2010

The Overall Consumer Price Index (CPI) for the Palestinian Territory with its 2004 base year (2004=100) reached 130.68 in September 2010, it increased by 1.39% compared with August 2010, and increased by 3.49% compared with September 2009.

Analysis of consumer price developments for September indicates **increases** in the following major expenditure groups:

-	Food and soft drinks	+ 3.09%
-	Miscellaneous goods and services	+ 0.74%
-	Medical care	+ 0.51%
-	Education	+ 0.43%
-	Housing	+ 0.41%
-	Furniture, household goods	+ 0.18%
_	Communications	+ 0.10%

At the same time, there were **decreases** in other major expenditure groups including:

-	Restaurants, cafes and hotels	- 0.46%
_	Transportation	- 0.32%

Palestinian Territory **regions** experienced different overall CPI developments as follows:

-	Gaza Strip:	+ 1.92%
-	West Bank:	+ 1.75%
-	Jerusalem J1*:	+ 1.06%

^{*} Jerusalem J1: those parts of Jerusalem which were annexed by Israel in 1967

The data of West Bank doesn't cover those parts of Jerusalem which were annexed by Israel in 1967.
