Palestinian Consumer Price Index Indicate Stability in March 2010

The Overall Consumer Price Index (CPI) for the Palestinian Territory with its 2004 base year (2004=100) reached 127.44 in March 2010, it decreased by 0.03% compared with February 2010, while increased by 3.77% compared with March 2009.

Analysis of consumer price developments for March indicates **decreases** in the following major expenditure groups:

-	Textiles, clothing and footwear	- 1.21%
-	Medical care	- 0.39%
-	Furniture, household goods	- 0.39%
-	Recreational, cultural goods & services	- 0.37%
-	Restaurants, cafes and hotels	- 0.36%
_	Communications	- 0.08%

At the same time, there were **increases** in other major expenditure groups including:

-	Food and soft drinks	+ 0.06%
-	Miscellaneous goods and services	+ 0.05%
-	Housing	+ 0.16%
-	Transportation	+ 0.65%
-	Alcoholic Beverages and tobacco	+ 0.02%
_	Education	+ 0.02%

Palestinian Territory **regions** experienced different overall CPI developments as follows:

-	Gaza Strip:	- 0.50%
-	West Bank*:	- 0.10%
-	Jerusalem J1**:	+ 0.31%
