Palestinian Central Bureau of Statistics (PCBS):

Palestinian Consumer Price Index Increased by 0.54% in September 2009

The Overall Consumer Price Index (CPI) for the Palestinian Territory with its 2004 base year (2004=100) reached 126.28 in September 2009, it increased by 0.54% compared with August 2009, and increased by 1.68% compared with September 2008.

Analysis of consumer price developments for August indicates **increases** in the following major expenditure groups:

-	Education	+ 6.97%
-	Furniture, household goods	+ 1.37%
-	Medical care	+ 0.83%
-	Restaurants, cafes and hotels	+ 0.53%
-	Miscellaneous goods and services	+ 0.40%
-	Transportation	+ 0.29%
-	Housing	+ 0.26%
-	Food and soft drinks	+ 0.28%
-	Communications	+ 0.27%
-	Recreational, cultural goods & services	+ 0.17%
-	Textiles, clothing and footwear	+ 0.16%

At the same time, there were **decreases** in other major expenditure groups including:

- Alcoholic Beverages and tobacco - 0.06%

Palestinian Territory **regions** experienced different overall CPI developments as follows:

-	Jerusalem J1:	+ 0.63%
-	Gaza Strip:	+ 0.42%
