Palestinian Consumer Price Index Increases 2.69% in 2007

The overall Consumer Price Index (CPI) for the Palestinian Territory with its 1996 base year (1996=100) reached 156.41 in 2007, a 2.69% increase relative to 2006.

Analysis of consumer price developments for 2007 indicates **increases** in the following major expenditure groups:

-	Beverages and Tobacco:	+ 5.23%
-	Food:	+ 4.75 %
-	Miscellaneous Goods and Services:	+ 3.15 %
-	Housing:	+ 1.61 %
-	Transport and Communications:	+ 1.21 %
-	Education:	+0.50 %
_	Furniture, Household Goods and Services:	+ 0.39 %

At the same time, there were **declines** in other major expenditure groups including:

-	Recreational, Cultural Goods and Services:	- 1.72 %
-	Textiles, clothing and footwear:	- 0.75 %
-	Medical Care:	- 0.06 %

Palestinian Territory regions experienced different overall CPI developments as follows:

-	Gaza Strip:	+ 4.04%
-	Remaining West Bank:	+ 2.52%
-	Jerusalem:	+ 1.40%
