## Palestinian Consumer Price Index Decreased by 0.28% in February 2010

The Overall Consumer Price Index (CPI) for the Palestinian Territory with its 2004 base year (2004=100) reached 127.48 in February 2010, it decreased by 0.28% compared with January 2010, while increased by 4.88% compared with February 2009.

Analysis of consumer price developments for February indicates **decreases** in the following major expenditure groups:

-	Food and soft drinks	- 0.98%
-	Communications	- 0.06%
-	Miscellaneous goods and services	- 0.05%

At the same time, there were **increases** in other major expenditure groups including:

-	Restaurants, cafes and hotels	+ 0.77%
-	Housing	+ 0.39%
-	Textiles, clothing and footwear	+ 0.37%
-	Transportation	+ 0.28%
-	Recreational, cultural goods & services	+ 0.27%
-	Alcoholic Beverages and tobacco	+ 0.17%
-	Furniture, household goods	+ 0.13%
_	Medical care	+ 0.11%

Palestinian Territory **regions** experienced different overall CPI developments as follows:

-	Gaza Strip:	- 0.73%
-	Jerusalem J1**:	- 0.41%
-	West Bank*:	- 0.26%
