Existing Building, 2010 A rise at the level of the West Bank as compared with the previous year:

The results of the survey indicated that the value of constructing new buildings and additions in the Palestinian Territory* in 2010 was US\$ 657 million, distributed by construction activity type (new construction: US\$ 299 million and additions of vertical or horizontal construction: US\$ 358 million), while the value distributed according to activity stage as follows: unfinished construction: was US\$ 374 million and finished construction was US\$ 283 million.


20% of the cost of current maintenance and capital repair and improvements in Gaza Strip

The cost of current maintenance on existing buildings was US\$ 136.7 million for 2010 US\$ 108.9 million for the West Bank and US\$ 27.8 million for Gaza Strip.

The capital repair and improvements cost for existing buildings totaled US\$ 364.3 million in 2010, US\$ 290.7 million for the West Bank and US\$ 73.6 million for Gaza Strip.

The results also indicated that the value of constructing new buildings and additions in the West Bank increased by 23.2% as compared to 2009. The cost of current maintenance on existing buildings increased by 17.7% as compared to 2009, the cost value of capital additions repairs and improvements on buildings increased by 43.6% for the year 2010 as compared to 2009.
