



## Palestinian Registered\* External Trade on Goods for March/ 2011

**Increase of both imports and exports compared to February 2011.**

### Exports:

Exports increased in March 2011 by 20.7% compared to February 2011 and reached US\$ 68.3 Million.

Exports to Israel increased in March, 2011 by 20.5% compared to February, 2011.

On the other hand, exports increased by 22.0% to the other countries during the same period compared to February, 2011.

Exports to Israel represents 92.7% of total exports in March, 2011.

### Imports:


Imports increased in March, 2011 by 28.8% compared to February of same year and reached US\$ 497.4 Million.

Imports from Israel increased by 34.8% in March, 2011 compared to February 2011.


Imports from Israel represents 72.6% of total imports.

On the other hand, imports from other countries indicate an increase by 15.2% compared to February 2011.

### Trade Balance:

The trade balance (Difference between exports and imports) indicates an increase in trade deficit by 30.2% compared to February 2011 and reached US\$ 429.1 Million.
