Survey of the Perceptions of Owners / Managers of Active Industrial Enterprises Regarding the Economic Situation First Quarter 2012

Report on the Survey Results

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The Main Results

1. Performance of Industrial Enterprises in the First Quarter 2012

1-1 Overall performance

According to 13.9% of owners/ managers of industrial enterprises (15.0% in the West Bank and 5.9% in the Gaza Strip) the overall performance of their enterprises had improved during the first quarter 2012 compared with the fourth quarter 2011.

1-2 Financial conditions

13.1% of owners/ managers of industrial enterprises (14.4% in the West Bank and 3.9% in the Gaza Strip) believe that the financial situation improved during the first quarter 2012 compared with the fourth quarter 2011.

1-3 Borrowing and financing

Survey results show weak borrowing by active industrial enterprises from banks operating in the Palestinian Territory during the first quarter 2012: 97.8% of owners of industrial enterprises stated that they refrained from borrowing from banks, while 1.2% of them had applied for a bank loan on one occasion and 1.0% had borrowed on more than one occasion.

2. Challenges

2-1 Changes in the level of sales

39.6% of owners/ managers of active industrial enterprises in the Palestinian Territory (50.5% in the West Bank and 14.3% in the Gaza Strip) believed that the main reason for the decline in the level of sales was due to the decrease in consumer purchasing power in the first quarter 2012.

2-2 Obstacles to exports

The owners/ managers of active industrial enterprises in the West Bank during the first quarter 2012 indicated a number of difficulties that hinder their ability to export goods. 83.2% of owners/ managers of export enterprises in the West Bank indicated that the closure of entry points had the greatest negative impact on export activities, while 60.2% believed that the Traveling problems imposed on entering foreign markets was an additional obstacle.

2-3 Local and external competition

In the Palestinian Territory, 96.1% of owners/ managers of active industrial enterprises (96.1% in the West Bank and 96.1% in the Gaza Strip) indicated that the main product manufactured by their enterprises faced competition of some kind.

According to 54.4% of owners/ managers of active industrial enterprises, their main item of production faced local competition while 9.1% of owners cited foreign competition. In addition, 36.5% of owners/ managers of industrial enterprises stated that their main product faced both local and foreign competition.

3. Expectations for the Second Quarter 2012

In regard to the expectations of owners/ managers of active industrial enterprises for the second quarter 2012, 47.4% (48.1% in the West Bank and 43.1% in the Gaza Strip) expect an improvement in their situation in general, where 47.4% (48.1% in the West Bank and 43.1% in the Gaza Strip) anticipate increased production; 47.7% (48.3% in the West Bank and 43.1% in the Gaza Strip) anticipate an increase in sales in the first quarter.

4. Level of Satisfaction with Services Provided

There were variations in the level of satisfaction of owners/ managers of industrial enterprises regarding the services provided by private and governmental enterprises during the first quarter 2012 according to the type of service provided. The results were as follows:

4.1 Infrastructure and facilities

73.5% of owners/ managers of industrial enterprises in the Palestinian Territory were satisfied with services related to the water supply (75.0% in the West Bank and 62.7% in the Gaza Strip). Around 61.8% of owners/ managers of industrial enterprises in the Palestinian Territory indicated satisfaction with Electricity supply services (70.3% in the West Bank and 2.0% in the Gaza Strip).

4.2 The judicial system and conflict resolution

The results showed that 82.2% of owners/ managers of industrial enterprises in the Palestinian Territory are satisfied with the fairness of the police on issues related to their enterprises (88.1% in the West Bank and 41.2% in the Gaza Strip), while 72.0% of owners/managers were satisfied with the effectiveness of the Palestinian courts (77.2% in the West Bank and 35.3% in the Gaza Strip).

4.3 Facilities

In relation to facilities provided by government institutions to obtain required permits and licenses, 57.4% of owners/ managers of industrial enterprises in the Palestinian Territory were satisfied with the facilities provided (61.7% in the West Bank and 27.5% in the Gaza Strip). In addition, 27.5% of owners/managers were satisfied with the information provided to enterprises in the Palestinian Territory (28.9% in the West Bank and 17.6% in the Gaza Strip). Regarding the promotion of policies to assist the development of institutions, 27.3% of owners/ managers of industrial enterprises in the Palestinian Territory were satisfied (28.9% in the West Bank and 15.7% in the Gaza Strip).

5. Obstacles to the expansion of production of industrial enterprises

The owners/ managers of active industrial enterprises during the first quarter 2012 indicated a number of obstacles that hinder the expansion of production. About 89.3% of owners/ managers of exporting enterprises in the Palestinian Territory (88.1% in the West Bank and 98.0% in the Gaza Strip) cited the difficult political situation as having the greatest negative impact on the expansion of production, while 88.6% (89.2% in the West Bank and 84.3% in the Gaza Strip) believed that the low level of income per capita of Palestinians is an additional obstacle.

6. Difficulties finding qualified employees

11.9% of owners/ managers of active industrial enterprises in the Palestinian Territory (11.9% in the West Bank and 11.8% in the Gaza Strip) revealed that they had difficulty finding employees qualified in the academic specialization appropriate to the nature of their company in the first quarter 2012. Also, 23.8% of owners/ managers of active industrial enterprises in the Palestinian Territory (24.4% in the West Bank and 19.6% in the Gaza Strip) revealed that they have difficulty finding suitable trained employees for the company.
