Press Release on Labour Force Survey Results (April- June, 2009) Round

Unemployment rate registered the highest in Qalqilia governorate among the West Bank Governorates, While Khan Younis Governorate registered the highest among Gaza Strip governorates. More than half employed persons in Gaza Strip working in the public sector

This report is based on the labour force quarterly survey. Data was collected during 05/04/2009 to 02/07/2009, representing the 2nd quarter of 2009. The data of this round was compared with the data of the 1st quarter of 2009 and the 2nd quarter of 2008.

The survey sample of this round is based on the 2007 census sampling frame, 7,677 households were selected to represent the Palestinian society of which 6,308 questionnaires were completed (the sample in the West Bank was about 5,168 households of which 4,589 household the interview was completed, whereas the sample in Gaza strip was 2,509 household of which 1,719 household the interview was completed). Statistical checks and variance calculations revealed that data can be published for labour market indicator at all geographical levels.

Economically Active:

- According to the ILO standards, the labour force participation rate in the Palestinian Territory remains at the same level in the 2nd quarter 2009 it reached 41.7% compared with 41.4% in the 1st quarter, while it was 41.6% during the 2nd quarter of 2008. Also the participation rate of women remains at the same level it reached 16.2% in the 2nd quarter 2009 compared with 15.4% in the 1st quarter 2009.

Unemployed Persons

- According to the relaxed definition of unemployment, the percentage of persons who don't work nevertheless seeking or not seeking job, decreased from 30.6% in the 1st quarter 2009 to 28.0% in the 2nd quarter 2009, compared with 31.5% in the 2nd quarter 2008.
- According to the ILO standards, the percentage of persons who don't work, but seeking job decreased by 12.6%, from 25.4% in the 1st quarter 2009 to 22.2% in the 2nd quarter 2009, compared with 25.8% in the 2nd quarter 2008. The results showed that unemployment rate in the West Bank decreased from 19.5% in the 1st quarter 2009 to 15.9% in the 2nd quarter 2009, this decrease can be referred to seasonality and working in agriculture, also it decreased in Gaza Strip from 37.0% in the 1st quarter 2009 to 36.0% in the 2nd quarter 2009.
- Qalqilia governorate registered the highest unemployment rate among the West Bank governorates (26.0%) followed by Tulkarem governorate at 21.4%). While Jericho and AL Aghwar governorate registered the lowest percentages of unemployment (6.7%). While in Gaza Strip, Khan Younis governorate registered the highest percentage of unemployment (44.1%) followed by North Gaza governorate (36.5%), then Rafah governorate (36.1%).
- The results showed that the highest percentage of unemployment was concentrated among youth aged 15-29; the age group 20-24 registered the highest unemployment rate it reached 38.6%, thereof 29.3% in the West Bank and 57.0% in Gaza Strip, followed by 15-19 age group which reached 28.7%, thereof 20.5% in the West Bank and 60.7% in Gaza Strip, then 25-29 group, it reached 27.6%, thereof 20.5% in the West Bank and 39.3% in Gaza Strip.
- The results showed that unemployment rate among females who did not complete any years of schooling was 0.7%. Whereas, this percentage reached 33.7% for females completed 13 years of schooling and over compared with 14.7% among males. While the highest rate was among males who completed 1-6 years at 27.2%.

Employed Persons

- The results showed increase in the number of employed persons between the 1st quarter 2009, and 2nd quarter 2009 by 42 thousands employees, the number of employed persons reached 739 thousand in the 2nd quarter 2009 compared with 697 thousand in the 1st quarter 2009, also the results showed an increased of employed women from 131 thousands to 137 thousands between the 1st quarter 2009 and 2nd quarter 2009.
- At economic activity¹ level the results showed that the percentage of those who are working in agriculture sector in the West Bank increased from 13.2% to 15.6% between 1st quarter 2009 and 2nd quarter 2009, while the percentage of those who are working in construction sector increased from 10.0% to 10.9%. While in Gaza Strip the results showed that all activities was affected from the closure imposed by Israeli military authority, for that there was decrease of those who are working in agriculture sector from 8.4% in the 1st quarter 2009 to 4.8% in the 2nd quarter 2009, while the percentage of employed persons in commerce, restaurants and hotels sector increased from 17.0% in 1st quarter 2009 to 18.4% in the 2nd quarter 2009. On the other hand, the results showed that the percentage of employed persons at services and other branches sector reached 31.0% in the West Bank and 67.0% in Gaza Strip in the 2nd quarter 2009.
- The results in the West Bank showed decrease of the percentage of wage employees, it decreased from 64.6% in the 1st quarter 2009 to 62.5% in the 2nd quarter 2009, and the percentage of self employed decreased from 20.8% to 19.8%, while the percentage of unpaid family members increased from 8.6% to 10.8% at the same period.
- While in Gaza Strip the percentage of wage employees increased from 73.7.0% to 79.5%, whereas the percentage of self employed decreased from 14.9% to 13.29% and the percentage of unpaid family members decreased from 6.1% to 3.5% at the same period.
- The employment from the West Bank in Israel and Israeli settlements remains at the same level it reached 13.8% in the 2nd quarter 2009 compared with 14.0% in the 1st quarter 2009, whereas in Gaza Strip there was no access for workers to enter Israeli settlements.
- The results showed that the public sector employed one fourth (25.2%) of total employed, (16.2% in the West Bank and 50.6% in Gaza Strip).

Wages and Work Hours

- The average value of the nominal daily net wage of employees worked in the West Bank increased from 83.8 NIS in 1st quarter 2009 to 86.6 NIS in the 2nd quarter 2009, compared with 86.9 NIS in the 2nd quarter 2008, also in Gaza Strip the nominal daily net wage of employees increased from 62.2 NIS in the 1st quarter 2009 to 64.0 NIS in the 2nd quarter 2009. While the nominal daily net wage for those working in Israel and Israeli settlements increased from 142.1 NIS in the 1st quarter 2009 to 145.9 NIS in the 2nd quarter 2009, compared with 143.3 NIS in the 2nd quarter 2008.
- The average weekly work hours in the West Bank increased from 42.0 work hour in 1st quarter 2008 to 42.7 work hour in the 2nd quarter 2009, and increased in Gaza Strip from 38.8 work hour to 39.5 work hour, while it decreased for those working in Israel and Israeli settlements from 42.8 work hour to 42.5 work hour at the same period.

Concepts and Definitions

Man power

All persons in the West Bank and Gaza Strip aged 15 years and over.

Reference week:

The week ending on Friday preceding the interviewer's visit to the household.

Employed:

All persons are 15 years and over who were working at a paid job or business for at least one hour during the reference week, or who did not work, but held a job or owned business from which they were temporarily absent (because of illness, vacation, temporarily stoppage, or any other reason) during the reference week. Employed persons are classified according to employment status as follows:

1. Employer
2. Self-employed
3. Employee
4. Unpaid family member

Unemployed (According to the ILO Standards):

Unemployed persons are those individuals 15 years and over who did not work at all during the reference week, who were not absent from a job and were available for work and actively seeking a job during the reference week. Persons who work in Israel and were absent from work due to closure are considered unemployed, and also those persons never work and not looking for work but waiting to return back to their works in Israel and Settlements.

Unemployed (According to the Relaxed Definition):

The number of unemployed persons was calculated under the relaxed definition by adding to unemployed persons according to the ILO Standards, those persons outside labour force because they were frustrated

Labour force:

The economically active population (Labour Force) consists of all persons 15 years and over who are either employed or unemployed as defined above at the time of survey.

Underemployment:

Underemployment exists when a person's employment is inadequate in relation to alternative employment, account being taken of his/her occupational skills.

Persons outside labour force:

The population not economically active comprises all persons 15 years and over, who were neither employed nor unemployed accordingly to the definitions above.
