Palestinian Registered* External Trade in Goods of August, 2011.

Exports:

Exports increased in August, 2011 by 17.7 percent compared to July, 2011 and reached about US\$ 63.4 Million.

Exports to Israel increased in August 2011 by 16.4 percent compared to July, 2011.

Also, exports to other countries increased by 29.6 percent during the same period compared to July, 2011.

Exports to Israel represented 89.4 percent of total exports in August, 2011.


Imports:

Imports decreased in August, 2011 by 0.1 percent compared to July of the same year and reached US\$ 344.3 Million.

Imports from Israel increased by 6.0 percent in August 2011 compared to July 2011.

Imports from Israel represented 63.7 percent of total imports in August, 2011.

On the other hand, imports from other countries decreased by 9.3 percent compared to July, 2011.



Trade Balance:

The trade balance which represents the difference between exports and imports showed a decrease in trade deficit by 3.4 percent compared to July, 2011 and reached US\$ 280.9 Million.
