Palestinian Registered* External Trade on Goods of June, 2011.


Exports:

Exports increased in June, 2011 by 7.7 percent compared to May, 2011 and reached US\$ 72.9 Million.

Exports to Israel increased in June 2011 by 5.1 percent compared to May, 2011.

On the other hand, exports to other countries increased by 38.6 percent during the same period compared to May, 2011.

Exports to Israel represented 90.3 percent of total exports in June, 2011.



Imports:

Imports decreased in June, 2011 by 7.5 percent compared to May of the same year and reached US\$ 366.5 Million.

Imports from Israel decreased by 10.0 percent in June 2011 compared to May 2011.

Imports from Israel represented 65.2 percent of total imports in June, 2011.

On the other hand, imports from other countries decreased by 2.6 percent compared to May, 2011.

Trade Balance:

The trade balance which represents the difference between exports and imports showed a decrease in trade deficit by 10.7 percent compared to May, 2011 and reached US\$ 293.6 Million.
