Press Release

On the Main Findings of the Survey on the Perception of Palestinian Population Towards the Socioeconomic Conditions, October 2005

"The optimistic expectations in the well-being of the households and community in general and the expectation of job oppurtunities are increased"

PCBS conducted the 13th round of the survey on the perception of the Palestinian people about the socioeconomic conditions. Data collection took place during the period 22/10/2005-11/11/2005 on a sample composed of 3,243 individuals aged 15 years and above, (2,076 in the West Bank and 1,167 in Gaza Strip).

Current Situation

33.0% of interviewed persons reported that the overall well-being of their households is worse in October 2005 compared with a month ago (33.6% in the West Bank and 32.1% in Gaza Strip), while 16.6% reported that it is better (14.4% in the West Bank and 20.6% in Gaza Strip).


23.4% of the households reported that the ability of households' members to move around is easier this week compared with a week ago (15.9% in the West Bank and 36.6% in Gaza Strip), while 8.2% reported that it is harder (9.5% in the West Bank and 6.1% in Gaza Strip).

Short-Term Expectations:

The 13th round, (October 2005) showed that 31.7% of the respondents expected that overall well being of the households will be better (25.5% in the West Bank and 42.8% in Gaza Strip), while the expectation during the 12th round, (July 2005), was 32.3% (25.5% in the West Bank and 44.2% in Gaza Strip)

29.8% of interviewed persons expected that the ability of households' members to move around will be better next month compared with interviewing week (20.5% in the West Bank and 46.7% in Gaza Strip), while the expectation during the 12th round, (July 2005), was 30.5% (22.0% in the West Bank and 45.4% in Gaza Strip).


40.0% of interviewed persons reported that they are very optimistic to find a job next month, of which 40.4% in the West Bank and 39.7% in Gaza Strip.



Mid-Term Expectations:

The 13th round showed that 34.6% of the respondents expected that overall well-being of households will be better in six months time (28.8% in the West Bank and 45.1% in Gaza Strip), while the expectation during the 12th round, (July 2005), was 33.2% (24.3% in the West Bank and 48.9% in Gaza Strip).

31.3% of interviewed persons reported that the ability of household members to move around will be better in six months time compared with interviewing week (22.3% in the West Bank and 47.6% in Gaza Strip), while the expectation during the 12th round, (July 2005), was 32.3% (22.4% in the West Bank and 53.0% in Gaza Strip).



Priorities of households:

Data reveal that 45.3% of the households reported the need for food as a first priority, 19.1% the need for financial assistance, 15.2% the need for work, and 6.3% reported the need for educational services, while 7.1% reported the need for health services as a first priority.

Priority Needs of Communities:

About 54.4% of households reported the need for job creation opportunities, and 20.2% reported the need for developing infrastructure services, and 9.5% for providing health services.
