## Palestinian Central Bureau of Statistics PCBS Release A Statistical Report about Agriculture Statistics in the Palestinian Territory, 2003\2004

## 1,824 Thousand Dunum Cultivated in the Palestinian Territory US\$ 555 Million the Value Added of the Agricultural Sector, 2003\2004

Palestinian Central Bureau of Statistics "PCBS" released a statistical data on agriculture statistics in the Palestinian Territory for the agricultural year 2003\2004, data reveal that the area cultivated with field crops, fruit trees, vegetables, and cut flowers in the Palestinian Territory amounted to 1,824 thousand dunum, compared with 1,815 thousand dunum in 2002/2003.

Fruit trees constituted 63.2% from the total cultivated area of the Palestinian Territory. While field crops and vegetables production comprised 26.9% and 9.9% of the cultivated Palestinian areas respectively; 69.3% of the cultivated area in Gaza Strip rely on irrigation compared with only 7.9% in the West Bank.

The livestock production was as follows: cattle, 32,395 in 2003/2004 compared with 33,235 in 2002/2003 with 2.5% decrease, sheep, 811,864 in 2003/2004 compared with 828,678 in 2002/2003 with 2.0% decrease, and 398,821 goats in 2003/2004 compared with 392,122 in 2002/2003 with 1.7% increase. 33,533 thousands broiler chickens, and 2,513 thousands layer chickens the number of chickens reported in 2003/2004.

The value added of agricultural production of the Palestinian Territory amounted to about US\$ 555 million which shows increase compared with 2002/2003 which amounted to US\$ 416 million. Plant production constituted 74.2% of the value added of agricultural production (of which 68.1% in the West Bank and 31.9% in Gaza Strip), while animal production constituted 25.8% (of which 74.4% in West Bank and 25.6% in Gaza Strip). The value of agricultural production of the Palestinian Territory amounted to about US\$ 940 million, of which 57.6% for plant production and 42.4% for Livestock production. The cost of intermediate consumption was about US\$ 385 millions, of which 33.6% of plant production and 66.4% of Livestock production .
