Palestinian Consumer Price Index Increased by 0.63% in November 2009

The Overall Consumer Price Index (CPI) for the Palestinian Territory with its 2004 base year (2004=100) reached 127.01 in November 2009, it increased by 0.63% compared with October 2009, and increased by 3.19% compared with November 2008.

Analysis of consumer price developments for November indicates **increases** in the following major expenditure groups:

-	Housing	+ 1.65%
-	Miscellaneous goods and services	+ 1.43%
-	Transportation	+ 1.16%
-	Food and soft drinks	+ 0.59%
-	Textiles, clothing and footwear	+ 0.40%
-	Restaurants, cafes and hotels	+ 0.34%
-	Furniture, household goods	+ 0.13%

At the same time, there were **decreases** in other major expenditure groups including:

-	Recreational, cultural goods & services	- 0.01%
-	Communications	- 0.03%
-	Medical care	- 0.05%
_	Alcoholic Beverages and tobacco	- 0.07%

Palestinian Territory **regions** experienced different overall CPI developments as follows:

-	West Bank*:	+ 1.03%
-	Gaza Strip:	+ 0.91%
