Palestinian Consumer Price Index Increases 0.35% in January 2007

The overall Consumer Price Index (CPI) for the Palestinian Territory with its 1996 base year (1996=100) reached 154.03 in January 2007, a 0.35% increase relative to December 2006.

Analysis of consumer price developments for January indicates **increases** in the following major expenditure groups:

-	Food:	+ 0.93 %
-	Medical Care:	+ 0.18 %
-	Furniture, Household Goods and Services:	+ 0.07 %
-	Beverages and Tobacco:	+ 0.05 %
_	Transport and Communications:	+ 0.01 %

At the same time, there were **declines** in other major expenditure groups including:

-	Recreational, Cultural Goods and Services:	- 0.43 %
-	Miscellaneous Goods and Services:	- 0.34 %
-	Education:	- 0.02 %
-	Textiles, Clothing and Footwear:	- 0.01 %

Palestinian Territory regions experienced different overall CPI developments as follows:

-	Gaza Strip:	+ 0.65%
-	Remaining West Bank:	+ 0.58%
-	Jerusalem:	- 0.20%
