



## Palestinian Registered\* External Trade in Goods of April, 2012.

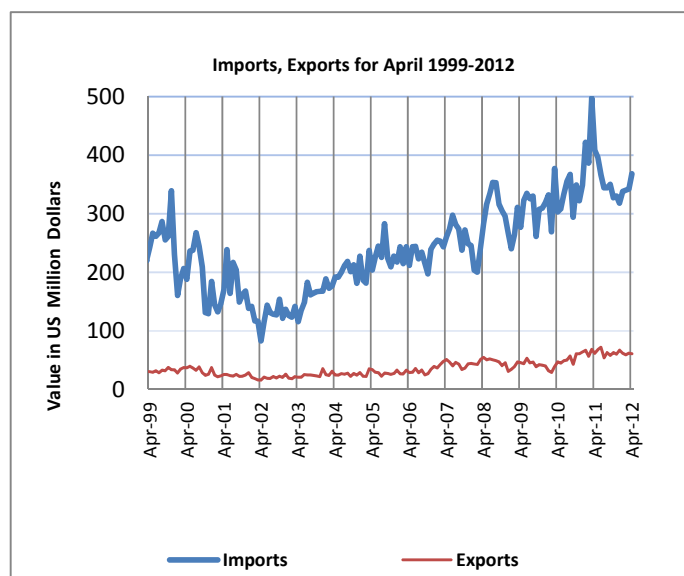
### Exports:

Exports decreased in April, 2012 by 1.4 percent compared to March, 2012 and decreased by 1.6 percent compared to April, 2011 and reached USD 60.7 Million.

Exports to Israel decreased in April, 2012 by 2.5 percent compared to March, 2012.

Also, exports to other countries increased by 6.3 percent during the same period compared to April, 2012.

Exports to Israel represented 87.5 percent of total exports in April, 2012.



### Imports:

Imports increased in April, 2012 by 7.6 percent compared to March, 2012. And decreased by 16.8 percent compared to April, 2011 and reached USD 367.5 Million.

Imports from Israel increased by 4.3 percent in April, 2012 compared to March, 2012.

Imports from Israel represented 67.1 percent of total imports in April, 2012.

On the other hand, imports from other countries increased by 15.0 percent compared to March, 2012.

### Net Trade Balance on Registered Goods:

The trade balance which represents the difference between exports and imports showed an increase in trade deficit by 9.0 percent compared to March, 2012. And decreased by 11.4 percent compared to April, 2011 and reached USD 306.9 Million.
