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# Press Release on Labour Force Survey Results (April- June, 2008) Round

# Unemployment rate in Gaza Strip increased while it decreased in the West Bank in the 2nd quarter 2008

Public sector employed about half of employed persons in Gaza Strip (47.5%)

This report is based on the Labour Force quarterly Survey. Data was collected during 6/04/2008 to 3/7/2008, representing the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter 2008.

The survey sample of this round is based on the 1997 census (Updated on 2003).

## **Economically Active:**

• According to the ILO standards, the percentage of participants in labour force increased by 2.5% between the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter and the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter 2008, where it increased from 40.6% in the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter to 41.6% in the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter 2008, compared with 42.4% in the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter 2007. The participation rate of women increased from 14.7% in the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter to 16.0% in the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter 2008, the change rate is 8.8%.

## **Unemployed Persons**

- According to the relaxed definition of unemployment, The percentage of persons who don't work nevertheless seeking or not seeking job, increased from 28.9% in the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter 2008 to 31.5% in the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter 2008, compared with 25.7% in the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter 2007.
- According to the ILO standards, The percentage of persons who don't work, but seeking job increased slightly from 22.6% in the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter 2008 to 25.8% in the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter 2008, compared with 19.2% in the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter 2007. The results showed that unemployment rate in the West Bank decreased from 19.0% in the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter 2008 to 16.3% in the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter 2008, while it increased sharply in Gaza Strip from 29.8% in the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter 2008 to 45.5% in the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter 2008.
- Qalqilia governorate registered the highest unemployment rate among the West Bank governorates at 23.2% followed by Hebron 22.5% then Salfit governorate 20.8% while Jerusalem and Jericho and AL Aghwar registered the lowest percentage of unemployment (8.3%,8.4% respectively). While in Gaza Strip, Deir Albalah governorate registered the highest percentage of unemployment (64.3%) followed by Khan Younis governorate (51.7%).
- The results showed that the highest percentage of unemployment was concentrated among youth aged 15-29. The highest percentage registered for the age group 20-24; it reached 40.7%, there of 27.9% in the West Bank and 62.1% in Gaza Strip, followed by 15-29 age group it reached 37.4%, there of 25.3% in the West Bank and 61.7% in Gaza Strip, then 25-29 group, it reached 28.7%, there of 17.7% in the West Bank and 49.7% in Gaza Strip.
- The results showed that the lowest percentage of unemployment was among females who did not complete any years of schooling at (2.3%). Whereas the percentage reached 33.1% for females completed 13 years of schooling and above compared with 19.8% among males . While the highest among males was for those completed 1-6 years at 32.9%.

#### **Employed Persons**

• At economic activity<sup>1</sup> level the results showed that the percentage of those who are working in Agriculture sector in the West Bank increased from 14.4% to 17.1% between 1<sup>st</sup> quarter and 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter 2008, and those who are working in construction sector from 7.9% to 9.0%, while the percentage of those who are working in commerce, restaurants and hotels sector decreased from 21.4% to 20.4% and the percentage of those who are

working in services and other branches decreased from 36.6% to 34.3% at the same period. While in Gaza Strip the results showed that all activities was affected from the closure that is imposed by Israeli military authority, for that there was a decrease of those who are working in commerce, restaurants and hotels sector from 22.2% in 1<sup>st</sup> quarter to 17.0% in the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter 2008, and a decrease in the percentage of those who worked at transportation, storage and communication sector from 6.2% to 4.3% at the same period.

- On the other hand the results showed that the percentage of employed persons at services and other branches sector reached 34.3% in the West Bank and 61.4% in Gaza Strip in the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter 2008.
- On the other hand, the results in the West Bank showed a decrease of the percentage of wage employees, it decreased from 64.2% in the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter 2008 to 60.4% in the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter 2008, while the percentage of self employed increased from 22.9% to 24.1% and unpaid family members increased from 8.7% to 11.2% at the same period.
- While in Gaza Strip the percentage of wage employees increased sharply from 58.5% to 71.3%, where as the percentage of self employed noticeably decreased from 27.3% to 16.9% and the percentage of unpaid family members decreased from 11.3% to 8.5% at the same period.
- The employment from the West Bank in Israel and Israeli settlements decreased from 15.9% in the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter 2008 to 14.2% in the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter 2008, whereas in Gaza Strip there was no access the workers to enter Israeli settlements.
- The results showed that the public sector employed one fifth (22.7%) of total employment, 14.9% in the West Bank and 47.5% in Gaza Strip.

#### **Wages and Work Hours**

- The average value of the nominal daily net wage of the employees in the West Bank increased from 84.8 NIS in 1<sup>st</sup> quarter 2008 to 86.9 NIS in the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter 2008, compared with 76.9 NIS in the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter 2007. while in Gaza Strip the nominal daily net wage of the employees decreased from 63.6 NIS in the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter 2008 and 61.5 NIS in 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter 2008, compared with 63.7 NIS in the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter 2007. Also the nominal daily net wage for those working in Israel and Israeli settlements increased from 139.9 NIS in the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter 2008 to 143.3 NIS in the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter 2008, compared with 130.9 NIS in the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter 2007.
- The average weekly work hours in the West Bank increased from 41.2 work hour in 1<sup>st</sup> quarter 2008 to 42.7 work hour in the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter 2008, while it increased slightly in Gaza Strip from 40.2 work hour to 40.0 work hour, also it increased for those working in Israel and Israeli settlements from 43.0 work hour to 44.3 work hour at the same period.

# **Concepts and Definitions**

#### Man power

All persons in the West Bank and Gaza Strip aged 15 years and over.

#### Reference week:

The week ending on Friday preceding the interviewer's visit to the household.

#### Employed:

All persons are 15 years and over who were working at a paid job or business for at least one hour during the reference week, or who did not work, but held a job or owned business from which they were temporarily absent (because of illness, vacation, temporarily stoppage, or any other reason) during the reference week. Employed persons are classified according to employment status as follows:

- 1. Employer
- 2. Self-employed
- 3. Employee
- 4. Unpaid family member

#### **Unemployed (According to the ILO Standards):**

Unemployed persons are those individuals 15 years and over who did not work at all during the reference week, who were not absent from a job and were available for work and actively seeking a job during the reference week. Persons who work in Israel and were absent from work due to closure are considered unemployed, and also those persons never work and not looking for work but waiting to return back to their works in Israel and Settlements.

#### **Unemployed (According to the Relaxed Definition):**

The Number Of Unemployed Persons was calculated under the definition by adding to unemployed Persons according to the ILO Standards, those Persons outside labour force because they were frustrated

#### **Labour force:**

The economically active population (Labour Force) consists of all persons 15 years and over who are either employed or unemployed as defined above at the time of survey.

#### **Underemployment:**

Underemployment exists when a person's employment is inadequate in relation to alternative employment, account being taken of his/her occupational skills.

#### Persons outside labour force:

The population not economically active comprises all persons 15 years and over, who were neither employed nor unemployed accordingly to the definitions above.
