Press Release on Labour Force Survey Results (April– June, 2004) Round 310,000 Unemployed persons during the 2nd quarter 2004

This report is based on the Labour Force quarterly Survey. Data was collected for the 33^{rd} round from 3/4/2004 to 1/7/2004, representing the 2^{nd} quarter 2004.

The survey sample of this round is based on the 1997 census, 7,563 households were selected to represent the Palestinian society of which 6,262 questionnaires were completed.

Economically Active:

• According to the ILO standards, the number of participants in labour force increased by 15 thousand between the 1st quarter 2004 and the 2nd quarter 2004, where it increased from 816 thousand in the 1st quarter 2004 to 831 thousand in the 2nd quarter 2004, compared with 735 thousand in the 3rd quarter 2000.

Unemployed Persons:

- Number of persons who don't work nevertheless seeking or not seeking job, increased from 287 thousand in the 1st quarter 2004 to 310 thousand in the 2nd quarter 2004, compared with 170 thousand in the 3rd quarter 2000. This represents 34.3% of the total labour force, according to the relaxed definition of unemployment.
- While those who don't work, but seeking job, in the 2nd quarter 2004 reached 238 thousand which represent 28.6% of the total labour force according to the ILO standards, compared with 26.3% in the 1st quarter 2004 and 10.0% in the 3rd quarter 2000 (before the beginning of Al-Aqsa Intifada). The results showed that unemployment rate in the West Bank reached 23.6% in the 2nd quarter 2004 compared with 24.6% in the 1st quarter 2004, whereas it increased in Gaza Strip from 29.8% in the 1st quarter 2004 to 39.7% in the 2nd quarter 2004.
- Unemployment rate by educational attainment, data showed that the rate increased between the 1st quarter 2004 and the 2nd quarter 2004, from 20.7% to 21.5% among those completed intermediate college and above.

Employed Persons:

- The results showed an increase in the percentage of employment¹ for those who are working in agriculture in the West Bank (15.6% in the 1st quarter 2004 to 17.2% in the 2nd quarter 2004), while it was 11.3% in the 3rd quarter 2000. In Gaza Strip the percentage decreased from 14.8% in the 1st quarter 2004 to 12.3% in the 2nd quarter 2004. Also the results showed that employment in construction decreased in Gaza Strip from 9.3% in the 1st quarter 2004 to 6.4% in the 2nd quarter 2004.
- The results showed an increase in the percentage of unpaid family members in the Palestinian Territory (from 9.9% in the 1st quarter 2004 to 10.9% in the 2nd quarter 2004).
- The results showed that the percentage for self employed decreased in the West Bank from 29.3% in the 1st quarter 2004 to 28.3% in the 2nd quarter 2004, while it increased in Gaza Strip from 21.7% in the 1st quarter 2004 to 22.9% in the 2nd quarter 2004. The results showed that wage employees decreased in the Palestinian Territory reached 57.8% in the 2nd quarter 2004 compared with 59.2% in the 1st quarter 2004, the percentage decreased in Gaza Strip from 66.6% in the 1st quarter to 65.2% in the 2nd quarter 2004. Also it decreased slightly in the West Bank from 55.9% in the 1st quarter 2004 to 55.1% in the 2nd quarter 2004.

Employees from the West Bank working in Israel and Israeli settlements decreased during the 2nd quarter 2004 compared with the 1st quarter 2004, they reached 48 thousand compared with 50 thousand in the 1st quarter 2004, while the number decreased in Gaza strip from 6 thousand in the 1st guarter 2004 to less than 500 in the 2nd guarter 2004.

Wages:

The average value of the nominal daily net wage of the employees in the West Bank increased from 72.5 NIS in 1st quarter 2004 to 74.7 NIS in the 2nd quarter 2004, compared with 70.3 NIS in the 3rd quarter 2000. While the nominal daily net wage of the employees in Gaza Strip increased from 55.6 NIS in the 1st quarter 2004 to 59.7 NIS in the 2nd quarter 2004, compared with 50.4 NIS in the 3rd quarter 2000. Also the Average daily net wage for those working in Israel and settlements increased from 127.5 NIS in the 1st quarter 2004 to 133.3 NIS in the 2nd quarter 2004, compared with 110.8 NIS in the 3rd quarter 2000.

Dependency Ratio and Poverty:

- The economic dependency ratio² increased in the Palestinian Territory from 4.8 in the 3rd quarter 2000 to 6.4 in the 2nd quarter 2004 (the change rate is 33.3%). Whereas, it increased in the West Bank from 4.3 to 5.5 (the change rate is 27.9%) and in Gaza Strip increased from 5.9 to 9.0 (the change rate is 52.5%). The ratio in the West Bank reached 5.5 compared with 7.5 in Gaza Strip in the 1st quarter 2004.
- The percentage of employees whose monthly wages below poverty line³ increased from 43.5% in the 3rd quarter 2000 to 56.2% in the 2nd quarter 2004 (the change rate is 29.2%).

² The economic dependency ratio: Number of population *divided by* Number of employed persons.

³ The poverty line equivalent for the year 2000 (1622 NIS, for reference household composed of two adults and 4 children) was used for the 3rd quarter 2000. The poverty line equivalent for the 2nd quarter 2004 (1800 NIS, for reference household composed of two adults and 4 children) was used for the 1st quarter 2004 results.
