Palestinian Consumer Price Index (CPI)

Decrease in the CPI during March, 03/2018

The overall **CPI for Palestine during March 2018 decreased by 0.12%** compared with February 2018 (by 0.51% in Gaza Strip, and with a slight decrease by 0.09% in both the West Bank** and Jerusalem J1*).

The changes in Palestinian CPI for March 2018 is traced back to changes in prices of the following expenditure sub groups compared with previous month:

The Palestinian CPI during March 2018 decreased by 2.11% compared with March 2017 (by 3.13% in Gaza Strip, and by 1.89% in the West Bank**, while it increased by 0.17% in Jerusalem J1*).


The Palestinian CPI during the first quarter of 2018 decreased by 1.12% compared with the same quarter of the previous year (by 1.45% in

the West Bank**, 1.09% in Gaza Strip, and with a slight decrease by 0.04% in Jerusalem J1*).
