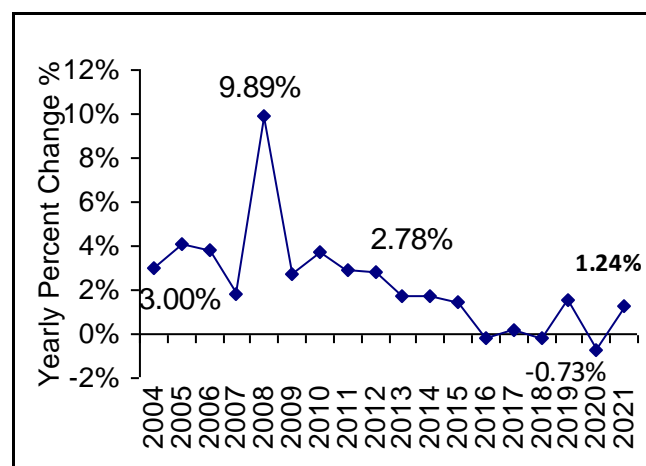
### Increase in the Consumer Price Index (CPI) in Palestine during 2021 by 1.24%

The overall CPI for Palestine during 2021 Recorded an Increase by 1.24% compared with 2020 (1.95% in Jerusalem J1\*, 1.41% in the West Bank\*\*, and 0.27% in Gaza Strip).

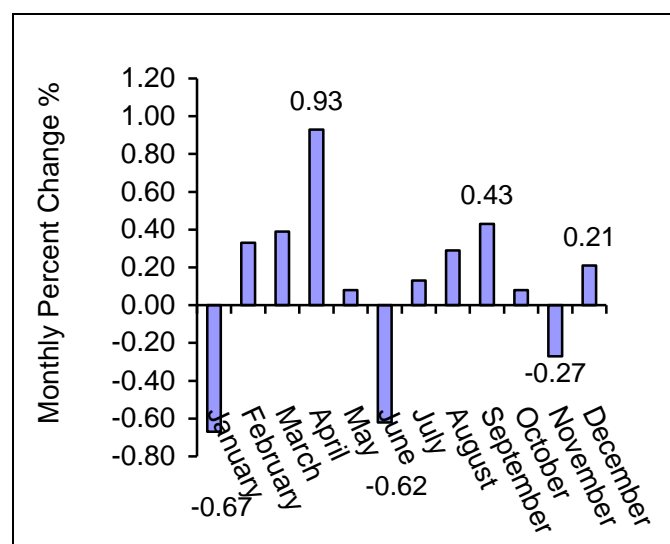
The changes in Palestinian CPI for 2021 were traced back to changes in prices of the following expenditure major and sub groups compared with previous year:

Major and Sub Groups	%Change
<b>Transport</b>	+ 4.39%
Liquid Fuel for Car "Petrol"	+ 12.05%
Liquid Fuel for Car "Diesel"	+ 8.62%
<b>Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels</b>	+ 3.65%
Actual Rentals for Housing	+ 10.51%
Gas	+ 5.92%
<b>Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages</b>	+ 0.86%
Vegetable Oils	+ 8.68%
Fresh Chicken	+ 6.72%
Other Sugar and Sugar Substitutes	+ 3.95%
Fresh Meat	+ 3.25%
Potatoes and Other Tubers	- 9.60%
Dried Vegetables	- 8.19%
Eggs	- 5.39%
Fresh Vegetables	- 2.02%
Rice	- 1.73%
